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**Sabres open up**

Acton Sabres open their on the ice workouts in preparation for the Junior "C" hockey season at Gordon Alcott Memorial Arena this Sunday night. The team has been holding dry land training sessions in Acton for the past two weeks.

Sabres are anxious to have any Georgetown and area boys attend Sunday's workout, which gets underway at 8 p.m. The club has benefited in the past from the play of graduates of the Georgetown minor hockey system.

Manager Bill Campbell feels that while the Sabres cannot compete financially with Junior "B" clubs, they can offer competitive hockey under slightly less pressure.

He expects the team to practice on Wednesday nights throughout the season and play all games between Thursdays and Sundays.

Orangeville and Meaford have entered teams in the Central league, bringing the league starting list to nine. Acton, Alton, Bradford, Stuyver, Schomberg, Huntville and Bracebridge are the other teams in the mixed Junior "C" - Junior "D" league. Penetang has dropped out for this season.

Craig Weldon, ex-Sabre goalie, who also played Junior "B" hockey in Milton has taken over coaching duties of the club from ex-Toronto Marlboro Dave McKnight, who moved from the area during the summer.

The club is rebuilding this year and with the exception of goal, all positions are wide open. After Sunday, Sabres will work out at Gordon Alcott, Sunday, September 21, Sunday, September 22, Wednesday and Thursday, October 1 and 2.

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**Ready for fight**

**Philbrook, Hill want Georgetown**

Halton MP Dr. Frank Philbrook wants Georgetown back and he and his staff are preparing for a fight to get the town back.

Federal electoral boundary changes for Ontario were announced on August 19 and the riding adjustments called for Georgetown to be lumped in with a new riding called Halton-Peel which includes the town of Caledon and the Townships of Vaughan and King. East Esquering was also lost to Halton-Peel. Included in the part of Esquering put in the new riding were Glen Williams, Norval, Stewarstown, Ballinacree and Ashgrove.

At the time of the announcement Dr. Philbrook said he wasn't sure what had been done to his riding but that he would investigate the situation.

Halton's MP has investigated the changes and says he now realizes that besides losing Georgetown, Erin and Ermosa townships have also been taken away from him, leaving his riding with only Oakville, Milton and Acton.

"Halton Hills Mayor Tom Hill and I will be appearing before the Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Commission the morning of Octo-

ber 8 and we plan to complain strongly about the removal of Georgetown from Halton," he said. The commission meets in Toronto.

He said in a recent interview that it is wrong to split Halton Hills by leaving Acton in Halton and putting Georgetown in the new Halton-Peel riding.

"Obviously they had an area left over which was short of population so they decided to throw Georgetown and Eastern Esquering in there. What we want to do is show them it is more important that Halton Hills be kept together and that this is more important than balancing the population in another riding," he explained.

Dr. Philbrook admitted most complaints before the commission don't result in changes.

"I'm not sure what our chances are of having these changes made. I do know the records show that a few complaints have led to reversals of commission decisions. All we can do is our best to change the commission's mind and have Georgetown put back where it belongs," he explained.

Halton's MP explained he plans to take his fight to get Georgetown back one step at a time but he vowed its decision to put Georgetown in the new Halton-Peel riding.

"I won't let this drop at the commission. I feel very strongly about this and will be fighting like hell to keep Georgetown in Halton. I will

stand the implications of the move.
