
THE GINGERBREAD HOUSE. This house originally built on the EBY FAMILY property, was lived in by the Seibert family and donated by the City of Kitchener 1964 from Madison Avenue. The house has undergone many changes as time progressed. Because of the Gingerbread ornamentation and outside construction it represents an 1890 Victorian residence. The central half upstairs displays clothing, dolls and the story of the green Santa Claus known as WEIHNACHTSMANN.



BUTCHER SHOP—by John M. Schneider. Many objects in this building were used by Mr. Schneider in his original establishment 1890. They represent the equipment used in processing meal and sausage years ago.

DOON PIONEER VILLAGE, is located west from interchange 34 on Highway 401. Buildings including a pioneer church, blacksmith's and cooper's shops, a general store and the Peter McArthur log cabin, are open to the public. A great variety of historical material relating to the pioneer community in this part of the province is displayed.


