Hyde fails to stop Tolton action

An attempt by Councillor Ern Hyde to stop any further legal action against the Tolton wrecking yard in Limehouse, failed Tuesday night when his motion was defeated seven to five.

He asked that any further action be halted until council could meet at the wrecking yard and try to resolve the problem.

Hyde said a compromise could be worked out which would benefit the town. He said the fact remains the road is encroaching on his property.

Mayor Tom Hill said Mr. Tolton tried to move the fence on Sunday, and wrecked it. Councillor Russell Miller said he was there Monday, and the fence hadn't been touched. He said he wanted to be fair but could not approve of letting one person disobey the bylaw when everyone else has to obey. He said the fence must be moved to the right place.

Councillor Les Daby said he would agree with Hyde's suggestion to meet with Mr. Tolton. He said the road location must be settled.

Hyde said damage to the fence was evident from the inside in a strip about 60 to 80 feet long.

The mayor again pointed out it is a regional road, and said he understood they had a survey of the road.

Hyde claimed a historical artifact known as a horse kiln is on the Tolton property and would be destroyed if the wrecking yard is moved back.

There was baffled disbelief on the faces of councillors when he said a horse kiln was a device that used horses with sharp spikes on their shoes to circle in a yoke to grind up rocks.

N. Halton enrolment far above projections

Enrolment at North Halton schools is far above what the Halton Board of Education expected it was revealed Thursday.

The board had expected 119 fewer pupils would be attending elementary schools in the north this year, but 293 more students showed up for classes than expected the first week.

Board projections had called for enrolment of 8,306 pupils while 8,599 appeared the first week of school.

This year's enrolment is up 174 from the 1974 figure of 8,425 but is still down 824 from the high of 1970 when there were 9,123 students in North Halton elementary schools.

Much of the increase is reflected in a jump in kindergarten enrolments which were 199 pupils over the board projections. Kindergarten enrolment is up 13.8 per cent in North Halton.

Board officials blame growth in the north, especially in Milton for the startling increases in elementary school registrations. They believe that due to new housing construction many families are moving to Halton.

During the first week of classes eight more pupils registered than expected in Acton and 19 more than were anticipated enrolled at Georgetown High School. Six fewer pupils than were expected showed up for classes at Milton High School.

There are 3,002 pupils registered in North Halton High Schools with 1,929 at Georgetown High School, 1,198 at Milton High School and 675 at Acton Acton High School.
