The Hearing before the Ontario Municipal Board commencing on Monday, the 15th day of March, 1976 will determine whether or not restricted area By-law 74-51 for the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills should be approved in whole or in part and whether or not amendments should be made to the By-law.

Restricted area By-law 74-51 is a comprehensive zoning by-law affecting all those lands now within the boundaries of the Town of Halton Hills that were formerly part of The Corporation of the Township of Esquesing. By-law 74-51 provides for the zoning of the lands within the former Township of Esquesing and in so doing regulates the uses which may be made of these lands.

**OMB reasons**

The OMB decision rejecting a drive-in theatre in Ashgrove, announced last week in this newspaper, was primarily based on the misuse of prime farm land.

In the six page decision handed down by W. T. Shriver and A. B. Ball, who conducted the December hearing, it was admitted a drive-in would have to be located in an undeveloped area where the land costs are less, but stated it should be another area rather than first grade farm land.

The board discounted the traffic problem, stating it could probably be accommodated with proper improvements to the roads. The reports stated the 75 acre orchard planned for part of the 100 acre site would not succeed, based on the evidence of two expert fruit producers. The board also took into account the impact on surrounding farmers and an abutting dairy farm in particular.

The report noted that owners of residences in the area had expressed concern about the proposed drive-in, but pointed out their residential use of the land is also taking prime agricultural land out of production. The document stated the number of farms in Halton had dropped from 1712 in 1956 to 1108 in 1971.
