The annual Acton Scout and Guide church parade went off extremely well Sunday afternoon.

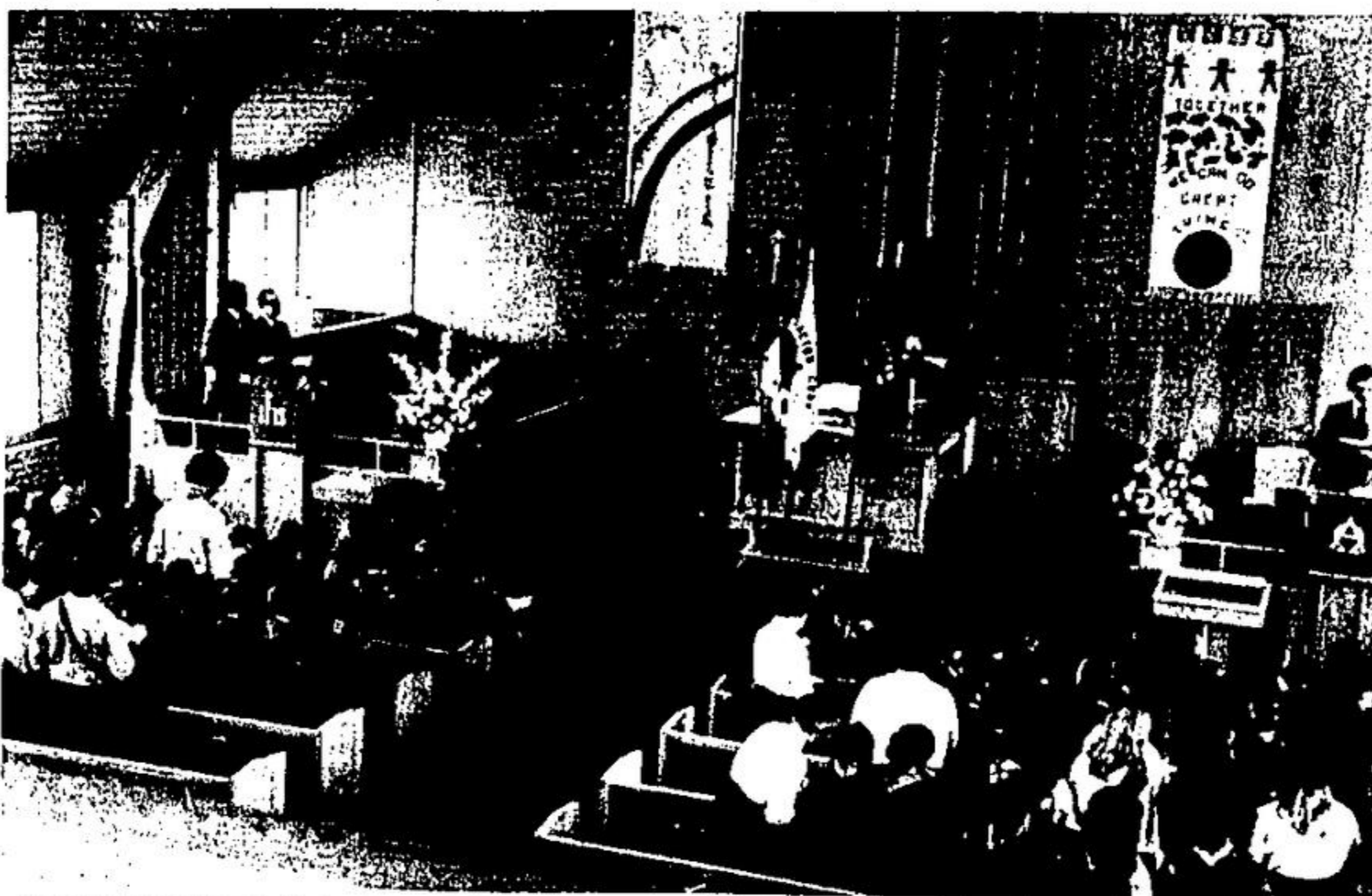
