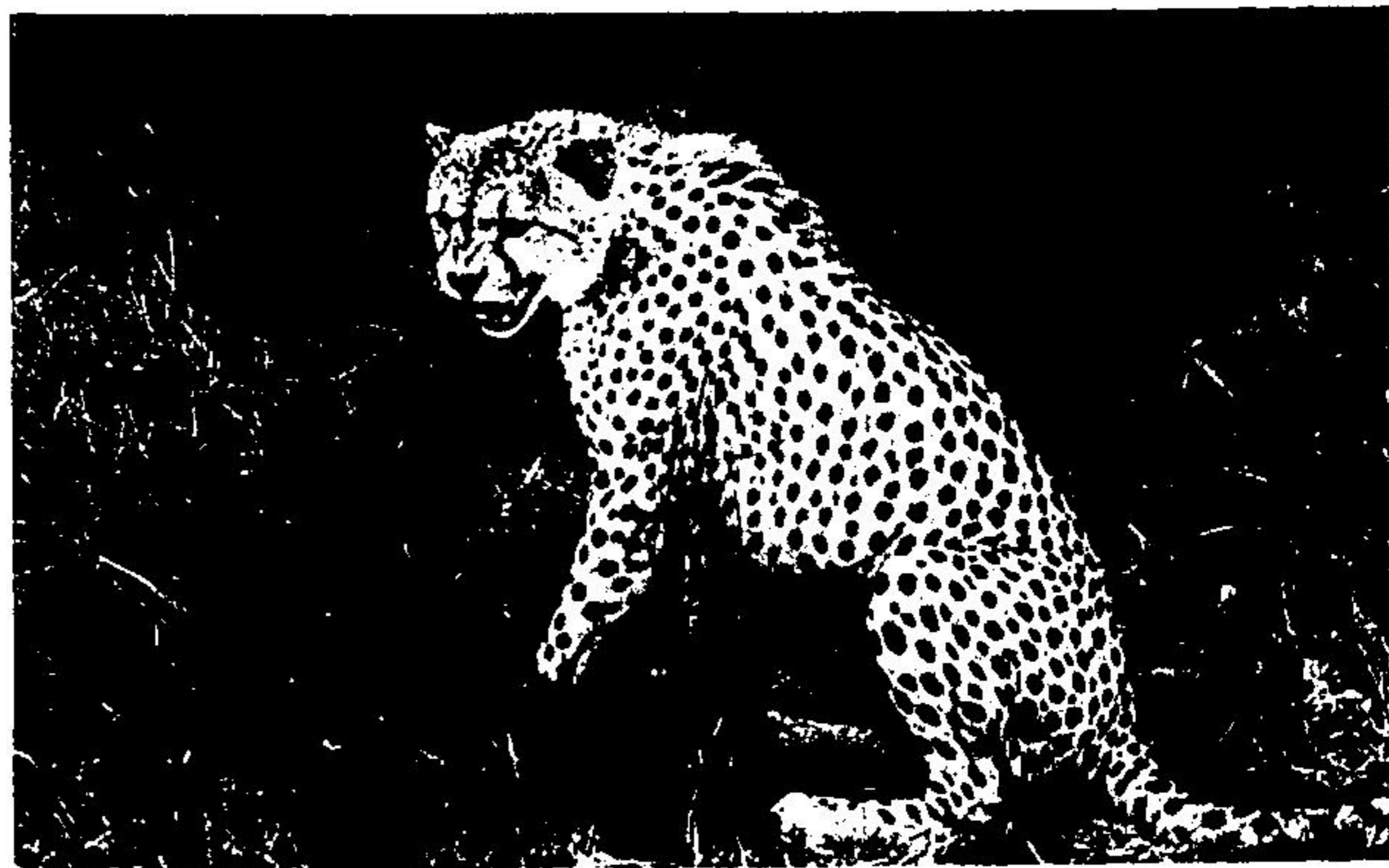


African Lion Safari



Just a short drive from North Halton lies an untamed jungle where you and your children's wildest dreams can come to life. African Lion Safari near Hamilton, is a 500 acre drive-through wildlife park that provides a total recreational and educational experience for persons of all ages. Visitors can spend a few hours or an entire day on safari, African style, in deepest darkest Ontario. Drive through in the comfort and safety of your own car or bus to view and photograph more than 1000 exotic animals and birds of 80 different species. More animals than you are likely to see on a Safari to Africa. Don't forget your camera.

African Lion Safari's open zoo concept allows animals to roam freely as they would in their native habitats. The six mile winding Safari Trail is your highway to adventure and excitement with a surprise around every bend. The trip through the six large game reserves leads the visitor through a dimension of time and locale, bringing together the four corners of the world.

The "Big Cats" are on the prowl, keep your windows closed, trespassers will be eaten! The world's largest private collection of Cheetah inhabit the first reserve sharing it with four Spotted Hyena. Mixed game reserves are part of African Lion Safari's continuing experimentation and breeding study programme. Further down the Safari Trail, young Lion and Tiger play together unaware that thousands of years have elapsed since their ancestors last shared a piece of common ground. In addition to Lion, Tiger and Cheetah, African Lion Safari features Elephant, Zebra, majestic Giraffe, curious Ostrich, Camel, the world's largest antelope, the Eland, rare White Rhino, and Monkeys galore, all of which have adjusted well to their new environment. African Lion Safari also specializes in presenting to the public North America's own wildlife such as Buffalo, Elk, Deer and Black Bear.
