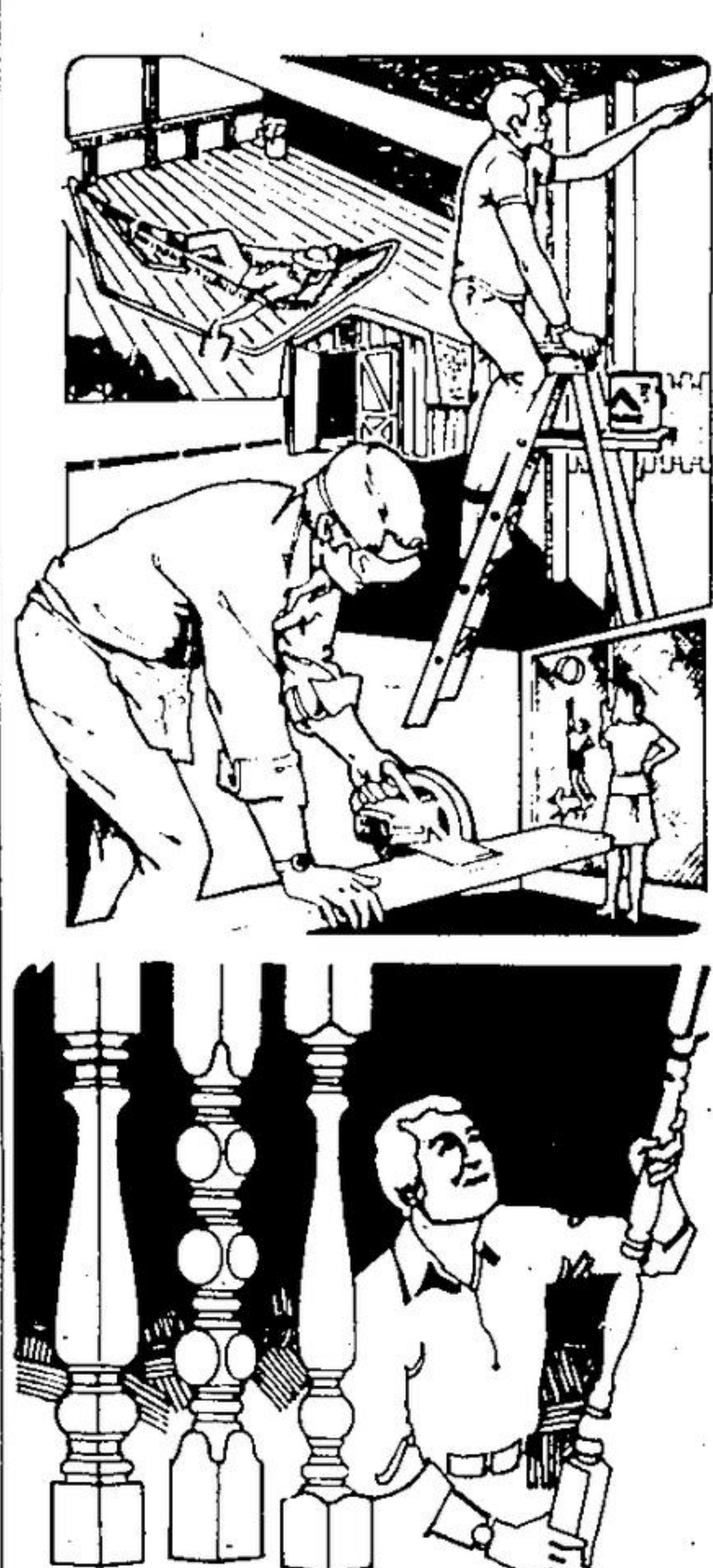

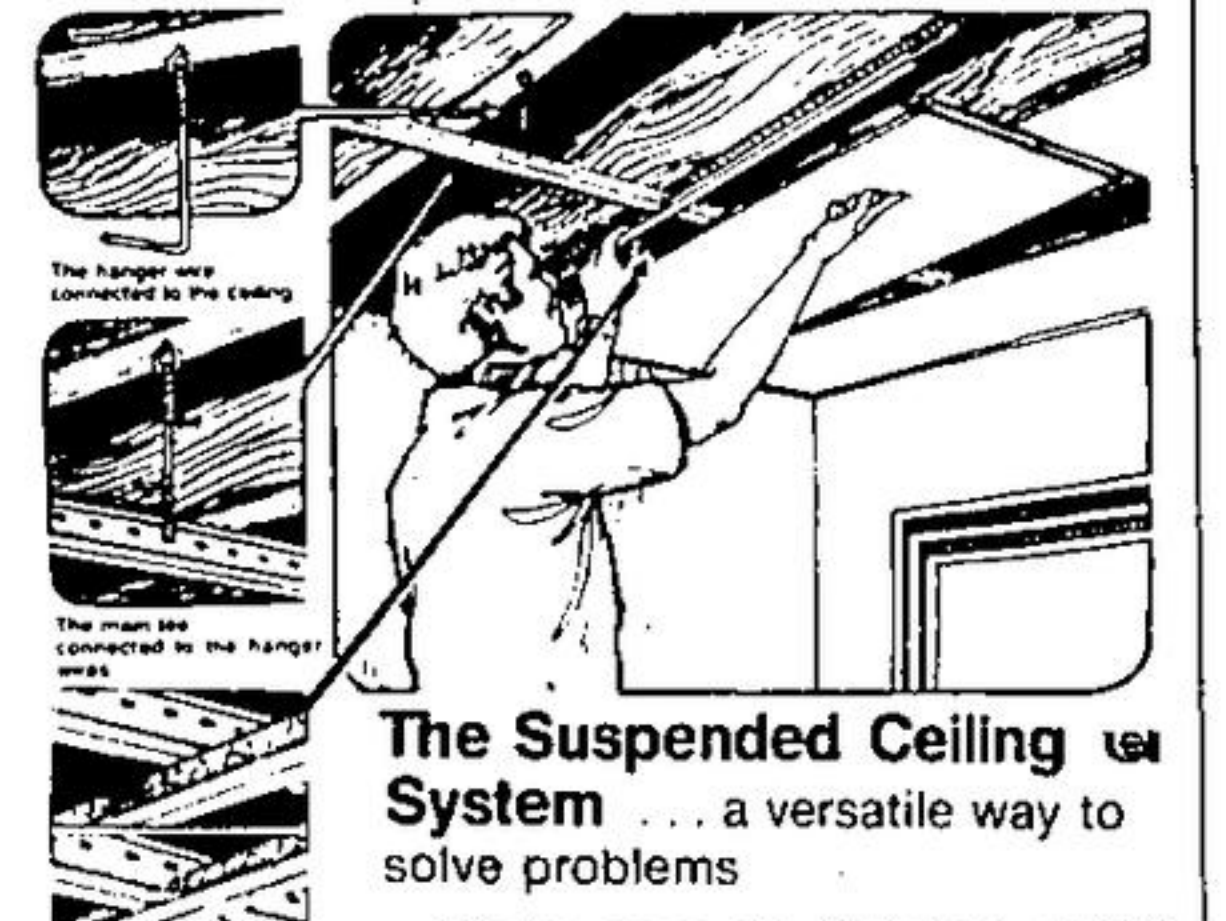
IAN CAMPBELL
