Plan to advertise dump direction

Halton Region's works department plans to advertise directions to the Georgetown landfill site, following a request from Nassagaweya Area Ratepayers' Association.

NARA executive met last week to discuss a number of current concerns and the main concern emerging from the meeting was—how do we find the dump in Georgetown—according to its chairman William A. Johnson.

The province closed the northern Nassagaweya dump at the end of May and residents are wondering where to go with their garbage, he said. Most of them have heard they must transport it to the Georgetown landfill site, but hardly anyone knows where to find it.

Mr. Johnson said he called the region's works depart-

ment to tell them about the problem, and a spokesman there said the region would place ads in the press telling people where to take their refuse.
