> According to Mr. Orr the region has tried to plug every loophole in the communication system and provide a system that ensures immediate action.

"Public works is one of the largest aspects of regional government. Future development depends on the services provided by the department. I see it as the hub of the region," Orr noted.

Works crew are continually working with industrial firms to control the chemical wastes that are dumped into sewers and play havoc with the waste disposal plants.

"The regulations are so. stringent we need continuous education. That's one advantage of regional government. You have the flexibility to shuffle staff."


