Halton farmers not hurt

Halton farmers have escaped a wet and frequently cool summer relatively un-Agricultural Representative Henry Stan-

ley said in a recent interview. "The only people who were badly effected by the weather were the cash croppers. Problem crops are restricted mostly to grain, especially if it was seeded late. I don't think there will be much effect on the consumer," he declared.

Reviewing the summer weather and crop success Stanley outlined the early success of grains and later failure of the same crop.

"We were lucky and had some warm dry weather in late April and early May which resulted in a good early grain yield and farmers were able to get a lot of it in then," Stanley explained.

Then the rains came and farmers had to suffer through about three weeks of continually wet fields which resulted in an extremely poor yield for late seeded grain.

The barley yield was especially poor because the crop was hit by yellow dwarf virus. Henry explained, that like many crops, barley couldn't be planted until later than usual because of drenched fields and small bugs spread the virus from one barley plant to another.

Corn was another story. Stanley said it grew well this

"The corn is maybe 10 days behind maturation because of the lack of heat. We are hoping for some warm weather in September for the corn. If we get it then there will be an average or above average corn yield," Stanley predicted.

There was an excellent hay crop this year he said but unfortunately a lot of it was spoiled because of rain and the difficulty in getting it off the field.

"A lot of the hay crop ended up being sold for mushroom compost," Henry noted.

The second cut of hay was. very good in most cases and farmers were able to get it off: : with little or no rain on it, he added.

Pastures were excellent and so were vegetables Stanley said. He noted while the vegetable yield was high the . crop was not without its problems since the rains brought with them many insects. As a result vegetable crops had to be sprayed more than usual.

Some varieties of apples, which had just blossomed, were hard hit when a late frost struck in May and some plums were lost at the same time. As for cherries, there was practically no yield.

He said consumers will discover there is an abun-

dance of vegetables but apples will be in short supply. There were at least a few positive aspects to this summer's heavy rains.

"There was no need for irrigations this summer. The grasses are very good because there was lots of moisture so it will be a good year for beef and dairy cattle and it certainly has to be good since prices are so poor," Stanley observed.
