**Hold the line**

Members of Halton Region's Administration committee took a hard line on budget guidelines set before them during a meeting Wednesday at the region's headquarters in Burlington.

The committee agreed that expenditures for ongoing programs would not be allowed to increase by more than 6 per cent over last year.

The committee acknowledged that exemptions would be made for special non-recurring items.

The committee slashed the CAO's recommended guideline of eight per cent to six per cent. Chief Administrator Ernie Reid told the committee the six per cent goal could not be obtained without CPI up 6.2 per cent.

He noted the consumer price index had increased 6.2 per cent by the end of August and the cost of living would go higher than that by the end of the year.

The committee members were adamant. Oakville Councillor Carl Erikson said the time had come to put municipal budgets under tight controls.

He recalled substantial increases in taxes in 1976. Noting that wages and prices were being controlled by the federal government Mr. Erikson said it was unreasonable to continue increasing taxes by 15 or 20 per cent.

When Mr. Reid warned the committee of the almost certain reductions in service Milton Councillor Jim Watson asked "what's wrong with a reduction in service. I don't think people are asking do more and more."

Realistic  
Oakville Mayor Harry Barrett said he felt the six per cent increase was realistic. "We might have to do more with fewer dollars."

Councillor MacLean Anderson of Oakville endorsed sentiments of earlier speakers. "The day is coming when local politicians will live in dread of tax increases. I've never heard the violent language before that I've heard this year. One woman called me and she was horrified but she made a lot of good sense," he said.
