V.O.N.-derful

Do you need a helping hand? Call on me. Who is me? Me could be any of the highly skilled registered nurses working for the V.O.N. (Victorian Order of Nurses).

The year 1897 should be considered a milestone in terms of improved "at home" health care for Canadians. The V.O.N., an idea nursed by organizations across Canada to commemorate Queen Victoria's Jubilee, became a reality.

Under the guilding hand of Lady Aberdeen, Governor General Aberdeen's wife, four V.O.N. branches were in operation within seven short months. The V.O.N. was responsible for the financing, training, and staffing of these branches. From this humble beginning 80 branches have sprung up across the country.

Available to most "In Ontario 97 per cent of the population has the ser-

vices of the V.O.N. made available to them," stated Mrs. M. Macleod, district director of nursing for the Halton Branch. "Only the remote north is not covered." coverage has developed a long way from

the early 19th century "remote cottage hospital" ways. In Halton, the V.O.N. is managed by a 22-member board of management. Board members oversee financial matters, hiring of staff wages, the purchase and maintenance of cars for the nurses, and public relations.

Financial support comes from grants made available by the regional municipality, plus Hamilton and Oakville United Appeal. This year an \$8,000 grant was given by the region. Hamilton and Oakville United Appeal gave \$5,600 and \$2,000 respectively. Patient fees

Fees are paid by the patient, private insurance held by the patient or government funding. There is a "sliding scale" of payment for people who can't afford the full cost of treatments, Mrs. Macleod explained.

Halton's V.O.N. branch restricts its activities to athome nursing, V.O.N. involvement in a case could result from one of several sources. A patient may be referred by a doctor, a hospital, or even neighbors. Sometimes patients themselves request assistance. Such requests are checked out carefully before any nursing activities commence.

'Special kind' V.O.N. nurses expertly carry out their tasks. They

give injections, change dressings needed following burns or for chronic open supervise mouth medications, and help out with baths. All patient work

'I prefer to nurse in the home, more than at the hospital. Helping to keep people in their home, where they want to be as long as possible, is very rewarding," she remarked. Mrs. Willoughby is both a

nurse and a friend to the patient. Such a friendship is most important since patient and family alike often have questions regarding the illness. If something is bothering them, they like to be able to "talk things out," she explained.


organization's This independence is fostered by the persistence with which the nurses teach patients, and their families. A patient's family might be taught how to change the dressing. On the other hand, a nurse could instruct the patient in how to administer his or her own in-
