There will be 10 new faces on the 24-member Halton Regional Council when the council holds its inaugural meeting Jan. 12.

All four municipalities will send new delegates to the regional council. Jim Watson is the only one of three Milton councillors returning for a second term. He'll be joined by Jim Kerr and Don Gordon.

Halton Hills will send Ric Morrow, Pat McKenzie and Tom Hill back for a second term while Roy Booth and Russ Miller will serve their first terms.

Booth and Miller currently serve on the area council. Booth defeated Ernie Sykes and Miller replaces Dick Howitt who stepped out of the political field.

Members of council will elect their own chairman, either from among themselves or from outside.

Should they elect one from among their ranks a by-election will be called to fill the vacancy.

Current Chairman Allan Masson is looking for another term in the top job. Councillor David Coons is also reported to be interested in the chairman's seat.

Recount?

In Oakville Mac Anderson, Archie Donaghey, Carl Eriksen and Harry Barrett will return. They'll be joined by Ron Planché, Laurie Mannell and possibly Gord Reade. Reade topped Bill Cudmore by six votes and at press time Cudmore had not decided whether he would exercise his right to call a recount.

In Burlington Jack Raftis, Mary Munro, Tom Sutherland, Vern Connell, Dave Coons and Pat McLaughlin will return to regional council. Mary Munro stepped from regional councillor to Mayor and will continue to sit on both councils.

Walter Mulkevich won his seat defeating incumbent Paul Preston. Other newcomers to the region from Burlington include Don Carter and Ben Ciprietti.

Bates loses

Pundits predicted that Noel Bates had a good chance of upsetting incumbent Tom Sutherland but Sutherland

At press time candidate Bill Cudmore was considering calling for a recount in his race against Gord Reade and Mac Anderson in Oakville.
