Milton Council to seek legal advice and authorize the pound keeper to set up a pound for large animals.

"It's been bothering us for a long time and little has been done. Letters aren't solving the problem," Bert Stewart told Milton Council.

Correspondence from the town has been directed to property owners Mr. and Mrs. S. Parker in Toronto and tenant William Murrant, but neighbors claim the animals still frequently stray.

Pound keeper Campbell Thompson told council he had been unsuccessful in establishing a pound for large animals and none existed in the region. The pound is required to be in the municipality, but permission might be obtained to take the

animals to another pound if it can be proven one is not available in Halton.

He reviewed the pounds legislation which required holding the animals where they strayed and impounding them. They are then released on payment of pound fees.

Mr. Thompson also reviewed the line fences legislation but noted it required action by the abutting property owners, with the Fence Viewers arbitrating. If the arbitration was not accepted the complainant had to rectify the situation at their cost and attempt to collect from the neighbor through the courts.

"It's time we quit fooling around," Mr. Stewart suggested.

"If there was a simple solution to the problem we'd have acted on it long ago," Mr. Thompson explained.

Mr. Murrant and the Parkers had been advised by the pounds keeper and deputy clerk the subject would be discussed at the meeting but they were not present.

OPP joins CB craze

The Milton detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police has joined the Citizens' Band radio craze in North America.

On Monday, the OPP officially announced they have installed CB radios at stations between Milton and Kitchener along Highway 401 for the purpose of monitoring calls on the emergency band.

Staff Sgt. Alex Grainger, of the Milton OPP, said the purpose of the radios was to allow CB users on the road to notify police of any accidents they might witness.

"We hope to cut down our response time to calls," he said. "By the time someone sees an accident and reaches a telephone to call us, 15 or 20 minutes may have passed. If they can call us on the CB radio this can be cut down."

Some truckers who are the main users of CB radios fear the police might monitor other bands to catch CB users warning other truckers of speed traps.

Police officials have said this is not the purpose of the radios installed and most truckers are in favour of the installation of the radios because they can radio in for road and weather conditions.

Staff Sgt. Grainger said the radio was in operation last week but only to receive calls. According to Sunday's log they had one request for road conditions and a notification of a possible impaired driver on the road who was later charged by the police.
