**Council cuts committee**

Halton Hills council cut one committee at the first regular meeting, Tuesday night. There will now be only two committees, with six members each. The mayor will be an ex-officio member of each.

The finance, personnel and administration committee will now handle recreation and municipal properties, and the works committee will take on fire and parks maintenance, in addition to the regular works committee duties.

Members of the works committee are Councillors Mike Armstrong, Pat McKenzie, Roy Booth, Les Doby, George Maltby and Pete Pomeroy.

On the finance, personnel and administration, are Councillors Russell Miller, Peter Morris, Pat Patterson, Walter Biehn, Peter Marks, and Ric Morrow.

The two committee plan was unveiled by Mayor Tom Hill when each councillor was given a proposed list of members at the inaugural meeting.

Councillor Pat McKenzie said he was concerned about the work load with only two committees. He suggested

with a committee of six, it might be possible "to ramp recommendation through council."

He suggested the finance committee had their hands full before the budget is struck, and with negotiations with CUPE. He suggested instead a committee of the whole system, where the whole council forms the committee.

Councillor George Maltby favored the two committee system, saying the plan and the allocation of members showed the mayor had done his homework.

Councillor Russell Miller said he would work under either system, as long as the committees could meet in the same building. Previously the finance committee met in the Main Street building, Georgetown, while the other two met in the Seventh Line building.

Mayor Tom Hill explained he felt finance and administration related to each other and should be combined. He said except for the pre-budget time the finance load was not too heavy.

He said the reason he suggested parks maintenance be

under works simply because the works department actually does the work. He said over the last two or three years there had been some confusion about the maintenance of parks because the recreation department controlled the budget but the works department carried out the maintenance.

Councillor Ric Morrow said two committees would be more efficient since only two secretaries would be needed, and fewer agendas. He pointed out with a four member committee, sometimes only two could be present. "Even with all present it meant four people were making a recommendation to council, and the whole question would be reshaped." He suggested after six months or a year, members switch committees, so their knowledge of all council matters would be enlarged.

Councillor Roy Booth suggested fire department matters be handled by the works committee, since he felt the other committee would be overloaded.
