Walter Lock kept records

Funeral service was held in Acton on January 21 for Walter Lock, R.R. 1 Acton, who died in Guelph General Hospital on January 19.

Mr. Lock was born on September 29, 1901 in London, England, the son of Fred and Frances Lock. He came to Canada in 1927, and married Emily Lillian Lock on July 16, 1940. On July 1, 1941, he and his wife moved to Acton from Toronto.

From 1945 to 1974, Mr. Lock

ran a service station at Crewsons Corners. At the time of his death, he was retired.

During World War Two Mr. Lock served five years overseas in the Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps. He was fond of gardening and kept records of weather for the Meteorological Offices in Toronto for about eight years.

The Rev. Peter Orme of St. George's Anglican Church, Guelph, officiated at the

funeral. Pallbearers were Stan Bowen, Mark Bowen, Ken Vickery, Jack Hol, Doug Guthrie and Gord Clow, all friends. Interment was at Fairview Cemetery.

Name Arbic director of parks, recreation

Larry Arbic was named Monday as Milton's new Director of Parks and Recreation, effective immediately.

Mr. Arbic takes over the post vacated by Bob Small, the former director who resigned last fall.

He was selected by council to fill the post after staff and the personnel committee reviewed 80 applications for the advertised position. Oddly enough, Mr. Arbic said he did not apply for the job. The personnel committee came to him and asked him if he was willing to accept the position.

Mr. Arbic moved to Milton from his hometown Acton in 1961 as manager of the Milton Arena on Brown St. He remained as manager until the end of 1973 when a new

position, Director of Facilities, was created by council and he was chosen to fill it.

Since Mr. Small's resignation last fall, Mr. Arbic has been doing some work in the parks and recreation office.

Although he has no formal education in parks and recreation work, Mr. Arbic said he is familiar with the day to day workings of the department, having worked from that office for the past three years. And he said he plans to attend courses and seminars as time permits, with council's blessing. The first such seminar is a two-day course on parks management he and Mr. Hendriksen will attend later this month at Humber College.

Family safety

Every hour, eight house fires break out in Canada. The Halton Hills Fire Department would like to suggest a few ways to increase your chances of escaping if a fire breaks out in your home.

It is essential that every family have an escape plan mapped out in advance of fire. All members of the family should be familiar with the plan. Once a fire has struck, your main responsibility is to get out — as quickly as possible. This is where a well developed and well rehearsed escape plan comes in. With such a plan you will know exactly what to do and how to do it.

The primary concern of the Halton Hills Fire Department is the safety of your family and because you have all safely escaped, using your plan, we can concentrate of saving your home and belongings.

Your escape plan should include some detectors. Even the best escape plans are of little value unless you are

alerted quickly that a fire has started. Also, detection is useless if you can't escape, so plan your escape now.

The following are some helpful tips to consider when making up your family's escape plan: Each person in your family should know two ways to get out of any room in your house: Sleep with the bedroom doors closed — it keeps smoke out; In a fire, feel the door. If it is hot, use the second way out, probably the window; If you're caught in smoke, crawl out, better air is near the floor; Meet outside at a pre-planned location such as a neighbor's house or a large tree. Do not re-enter the house for any reason. Many people have died when they went back; Never waste time trying to dress, save valuables; or telephone; Call the fire department at 877-3221 or 853-1212 after escaping — from a neighbor's home if possible and as soon as possible.

Remember home fire safety is two things — detecting fire and escaping from it. Be ready if fire strikes your home.
