

# Decorator opens small branch shop at plaza

Draperies 'n Things, a small new shop in Glenlen plaza, offers a new and unique service to Actonians. Olga Huscul of Toronto is here two days a week, and

Saturdays by appointment. She chose Acton for a branch office of her business since she had several customers here already, and they assured her there would be more people here interested in her personal decorating service. She finds she has the same customers year after year, so she needed a spot a little nearer them than the city.

She has a workroom in

Toronto, and has workmen, suppliers and designers on call in various fields if they

are needed. Her store is small, but packed with samples and books of ideas. Her chesterfield was sold right from under her recently, but she has a desk and small blue

chair left! Drapes first

Although her business began with the supplying of draperles for houses, Ms. Huscul found this extended into other decorating fields as well. It's always necessary to go to the house for measurements, discussions and in-

stallation, so one thing led to another and her field grew. She finds when she goes to a house to talk about drapes or curtains, the order seldom ends up the way it started out. "Ideas keep popping," says

this lively woman. Ideas change

Often the finished room turns out in a way that is much less expensive than the way the customer first envisioned it. For instance, Ms. Huscul says people often intend a full wall of drapery, but settle for a pretty single window treatment instead. Some Acton homes are built with a valance box along a full wall. You can wallpaper over them, or take them out,

she suggests. Many wallpapers come with matching fabrics nowadays and this introduces lots of possibilities-bedspreads, table covers or laminated blinds, for instance.

As a decorator she gets involved in the complete trade, including upholstering and re-upholstering.

Timid She finds many people who are timld about color, but they are always delighted with the result, after they get away from the common beige

or gold tones. Ms. Huscul remembers in particular a room she and other decorators prepared in the home of E. P. Taylor, which is where the Queen Mother slept on her last visit to Toronto a couple of years ago. The room was in muted reds with pink shades. The carpet was off-white.

She has also worked with other decorators in formal rooms in Ottawa. She received her decorating training in New York.

Often people are concerned about the expense of asking decorating advice, but Ms. Huscul says the cost is in the work, not in her discussion with the clients. She's been in the business 12 years, and is full of enthusiasm. She is always finding new ideas.
