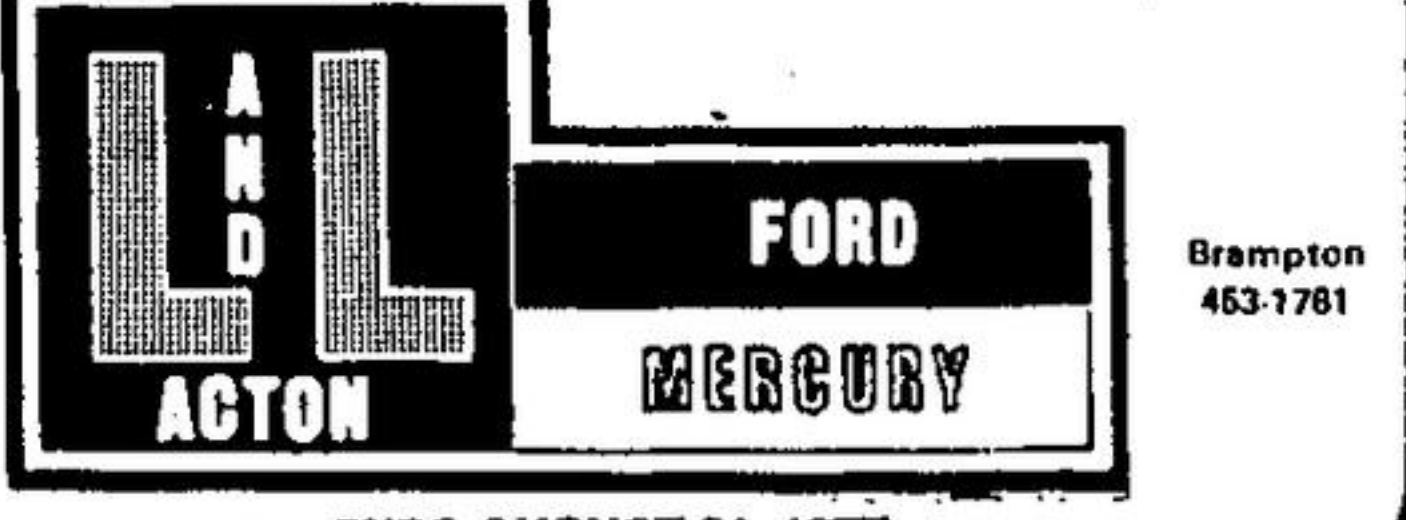

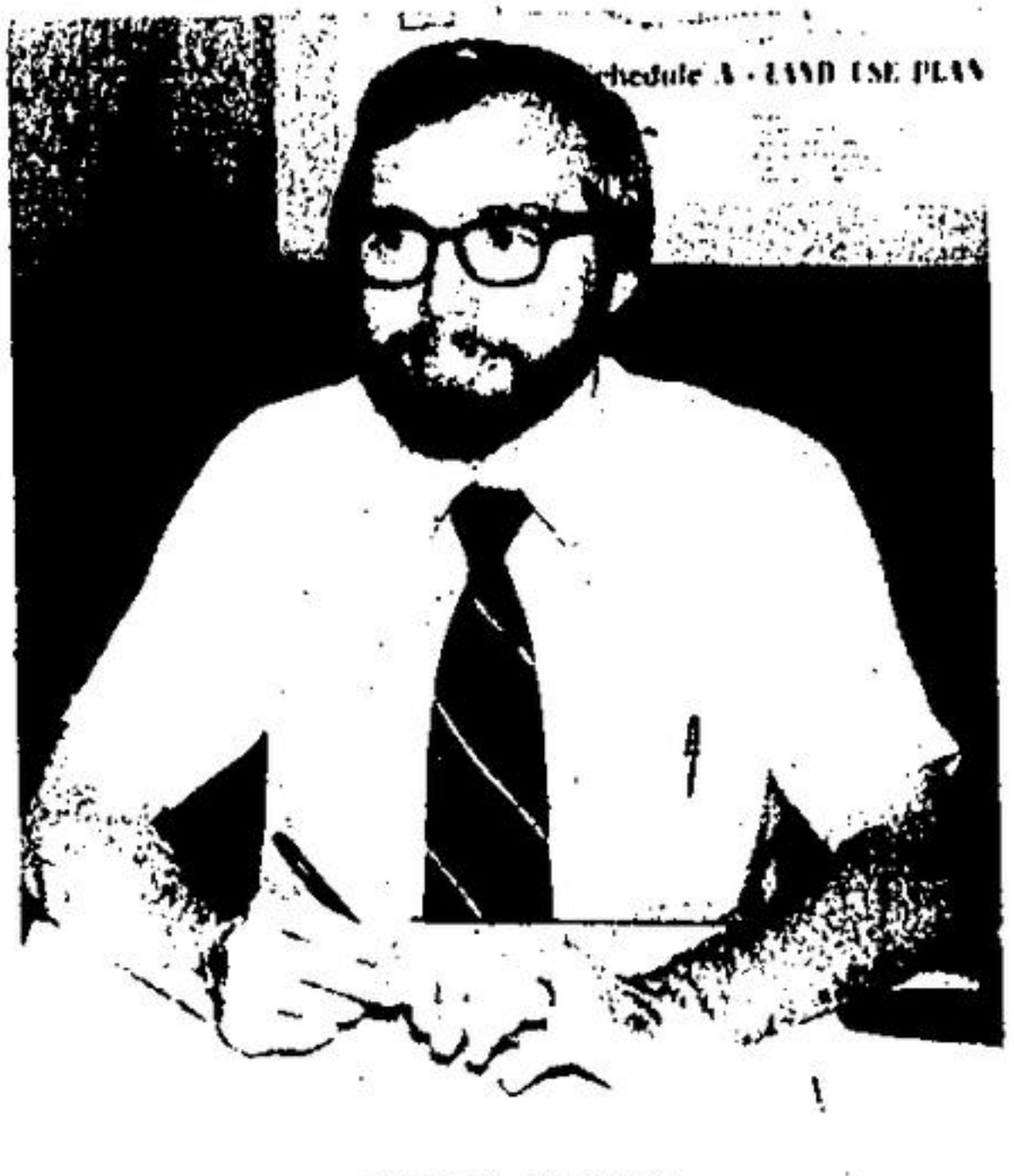

New planner at town office

Brian Kropf, a native of Waterloo, started work as the new Assistant Planner for the town of Halton Hills, two weeks ago. He is replacing Ron Burnett, who resigned two months ago.
Mr. Kropf graduated from University of Waterloo, with a Bachelor of Environmental studies in planning in 1972. After three years as planner for the City of Welland, he joined Halton Region Planning Department, where he worked prior to coming here.

Recommendation end recovery

Regional Public Works Chairman Jack Rafitis claims that the Bill 151 Committee's move to recommend turning water, sewers, planning and garbage disposal back to the area governments isn't in the best interest of the ratepayers.
"To say you'll give garbage disposal back to the areas is to say you don't want resource recovery, because there is no way the municipalities can afford to go that alone."
Rafitis argues there is economy in having water administered by one agency instead of four or five PUCs.
He claims regional planning will be greatly diminished once the official plan is passed.
Milton Councillor Jim Kerr takes a different view of the committee recommendation. "I like it," Kerr said in an interview.
He claims water and sewer services can be handled best at the area levels and he guessed that it would be 30 to 50 years before there is any need for a regional water and sewer system crossing municipal boundaries.
Under the current system, ratepayers can have that inflicted upon them regardless of what area representatives say or do.
"What good will it do them to turf me out? If it were a local decision and I was voting in favour of it, they could vote me out of office. The people making decisions at the region aren't accountable to the people affected by them," he said.
The region's Bill 151 Committee recently passed a motion that encourages conveying power from the region to area councils. The motion involved water and sewers, planning and garbage disposal.
The committee will report to council in the fall.
