# Brian Best dies in Milton

Brian Best, former mayor of Milton, died at Milton District Hospital, August 1, never regaining consciousness following an accident September 9, 1974. He was involved in a two car collision on Britannia Rd. then and it caused serious brain damage and subsequent coma...

Mr. Best was well known during his term of office as mayor of Milton. His untiring work, and astute decisions shaped the town of Milton's destiny. He retired from public life nine months before the accident.

Prior to taking the mayor's chair he had served on the Milton school board, Chamber of Commerce and ratepayers' associations. He was also a successful businessman, operating Best Real Estate.




