It is one of the most concentrated food sources known and Olympic athletes take it, he reported. On an average, one new health food store opens up in Canada every week as interest in nutrition and health grows.

The Martins would like to expand their warehouse space, and their organic garden plot.

Mr. Martin has been in this business for 24 years now.

She feels a local chapter would benefit the parents greatly. A meeting is planned for August 17 in Stewarville Hall to discuss the possibility of organization a local chapter. Mrs. Boys said that only 25 parents be interested for a branch to be set up.
