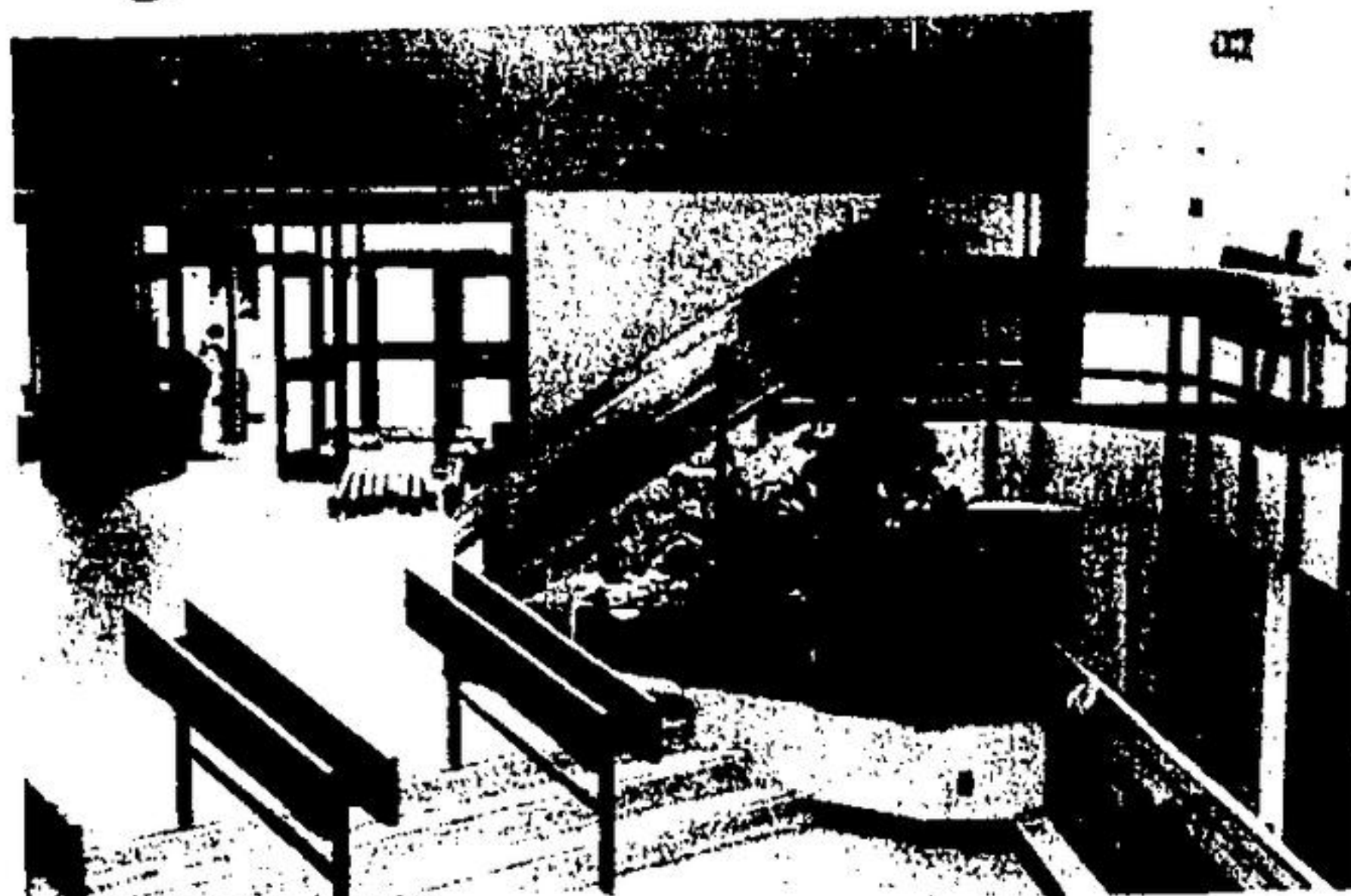


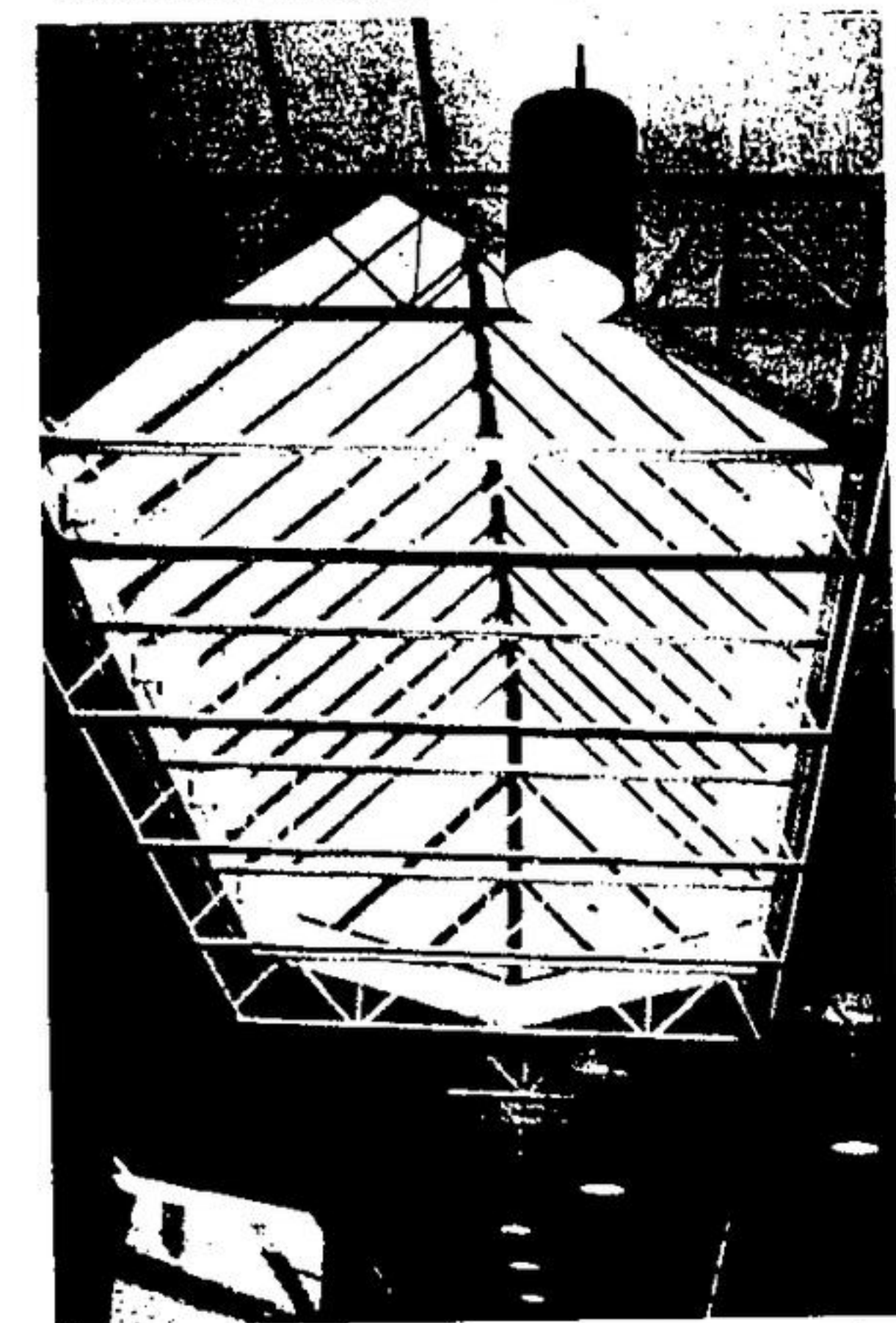
High school good example of shape of things to come



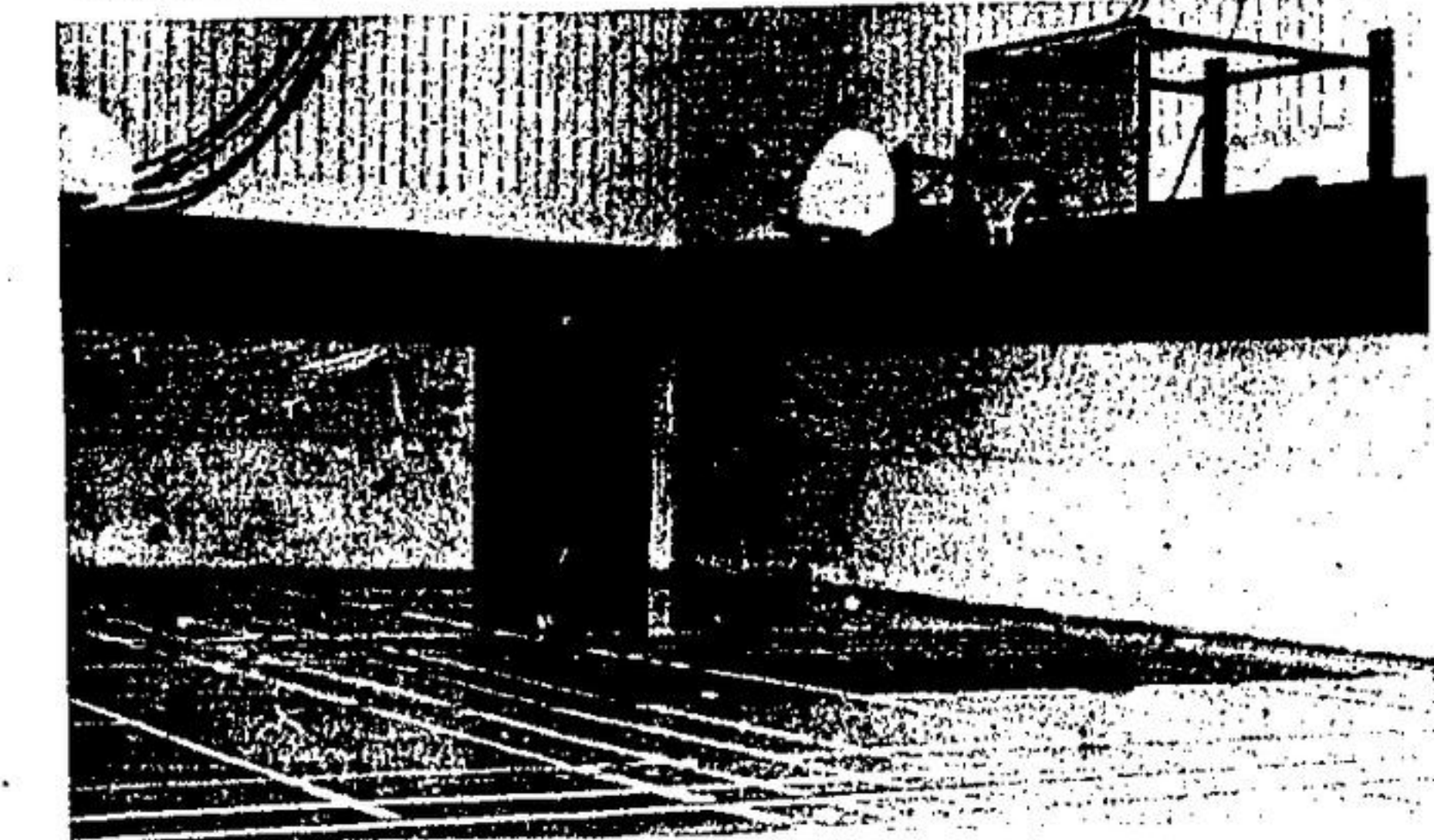
TREE AND OTHER PLANTS in the front foyer at the high school add to the cheerfulness of the design of the building.

The new high school is almost completed except for a few workers doing last minute painting.

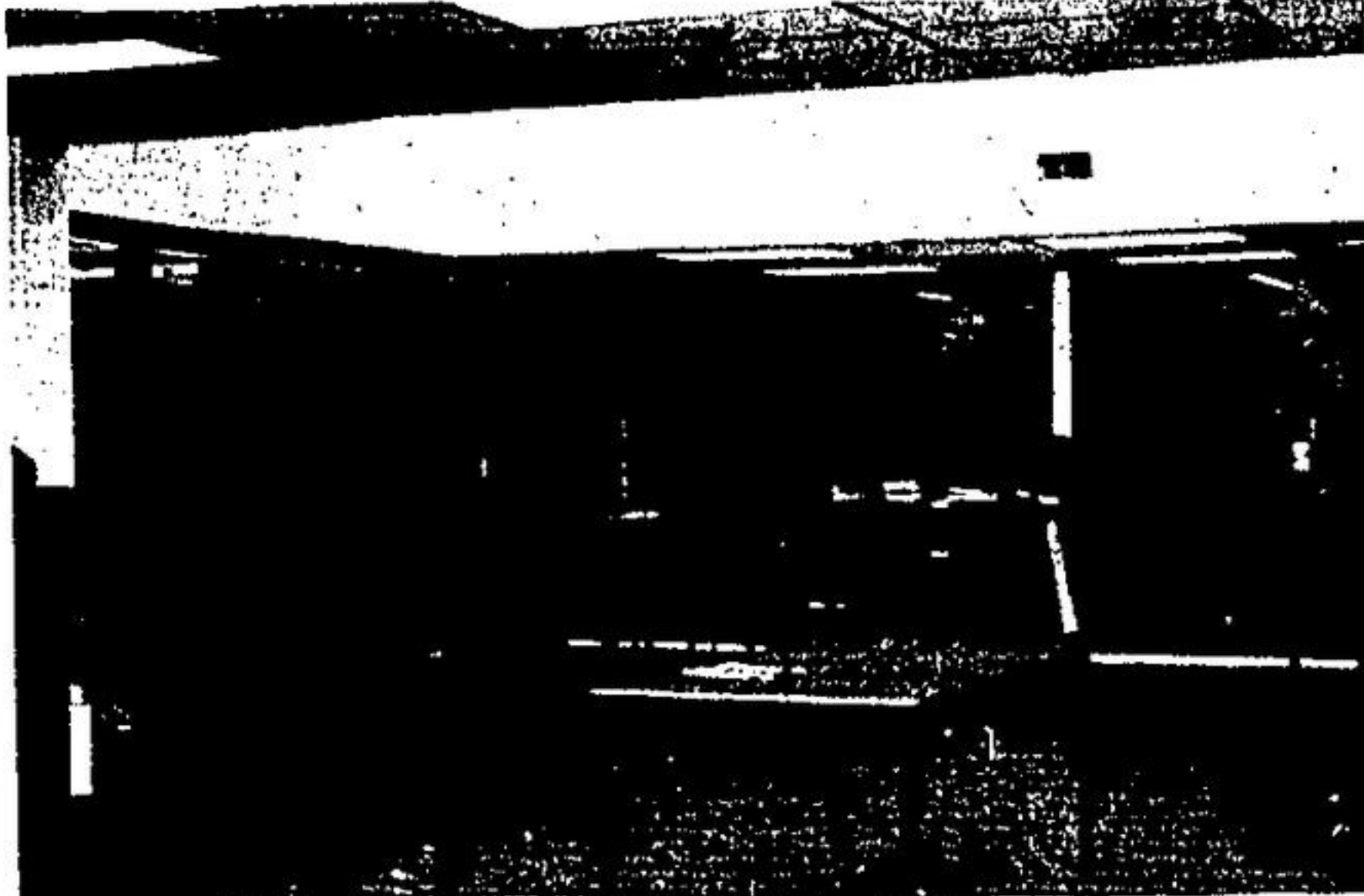
