

High school good example of shape of things to come


There is still a lot of unpacking to do, and some classrooms have to be set up. A few workers are doing last minute paint jobs on various

LIBRARY/RESOURCE centre is almost completely unpacked. Students can sit in individual booths to study, away from where other students would be looking at the book selection.




GEOGRAPHY CLASSROOM is ready for the students next week. The room can be divided in two with a folding wall when needed.


