'Soft' services

A recently funded project will establish an information base about health and social services in the region, said Dorothy Craig, director of the project.

"It's really just to help us look at social goals in relation to what we've got, so they won't be out of context with reality," she said.

A \$1,000 grant was awarded to the Human Services Council Regional Planning Subcommittee to carry out the project. The grant was announced by Dr. Frank A. Philbrook, MP for Halton.

"We need to know what health and social services are available and somebody needed to be hired to do that," Miss Craig said. "The members of the committee all have full time jobs."

Miss Craig, who is director of nursing at Halton Health Unit, said the person hired to produce the inventory will probably be a student. The inventory will include the numbers of staff and volunteers working in agencies in Halton.

Human Services Council has in the past compiled a directory of services for the region. Miss Craig said. However, no further copies are available and no group has picked up the responsibility for printing and updating it.

In addition to producing an inventory the project will sponsor public workshops to inform the community on how to use the health and social services available in the region.

Belfountain wading pool to be fixed

The wading pool at Belfountain Conservation Area will be filled in and a better wading place created in the river, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board of the Credit Valley Conservation Authority suggested at a recent meeting.

The existing pool, constructed prior to Authority takeover in 1961, has caused frequent problems, according to an Authority staff report. Major concerns include the difficulty in overcoming a silt and algae problem, creating a slippery pool bottom.

It was decided to clear a wading area in the river upstream from the bridge where water was not over the required maximum 18-inch depth. The area would be buoyed, sand added to make a beach, while the present pool would be concrete filled.


