If any of these things tickle" your fancy, take a jaint up to Highway 24 at Everton and have a meal at the newlyopened "Teddy Bears Picnic" restaurant.

Local people have watched. for years as the old stone house on the south-west corner of 7th Line and 24 was gradually face-lifted, renovated and polished into "The Old Everton Inn".

Unforounately, the inn was never opened-until now. Double Bear Farms

It took a lively person like Anna Spencer, partner in such enterprises as the Mohawk Inn and Campbellville's Opera Emporium, to get the show on the road. Mrs. Spencer's love of teddy bears goes back to the day of her birth when her father presented her with a huge English teddy that is still her constant companion.

Mrs. Spencer and her partner, Alex Hacker, run an organization called Double Bear Farms handling several inns and restaurants. They hope the Everton Teddy Bears Picnic will be the first of more Teddy's. Even the newly added disco room at the Mohawk Inn has a bear motive-it's the Three Bears Room.

Teddies galore

The character of the old house has been maintained. and enhanced by discreet use of antique furnishings, Tiffany lamps and a magnificent old colonial brick fireplace wall complete with cast iron warming oven for bread and open hearth for black bean pots and soup cauldronswith the real thing simmering in them.

But the pieces de resistance are the masses of specially made teddy bears arranged around the two main dining rooms. Elegantly framed pictures of the Roosevelt Bears (remember those?) and prints from English children's books catch one's interest. Wicker baskets of all types hang from the beams and grace the picture rails. Small baskets are for sale if mementos are desired. Shelves of antique "weird" teapots complete the theme and these are all from Mrs. Spencer's own collection. An addition to the back of

the building houses the coffee shop and tea room. It is cheerfully decorated like a country kitchen with hanging plants and more wicker. The menu combines hamburgers and hot dogs with home-made ice cream and huge honeyand-butter tarts, a definite threat to any diet.

Tea may be taken out on the wooden deck where brightly painted picnic tables and orange bathtubs full of marigolds offer a charming spot under the trees.

Down with diets

If the decor doesn't get you, the menu will. Anyone familiar with Mohawk Inn or the Campbellville Opera Emporium will remember the delightful home-made goodfor-you food.

At the Teddy Bear's Picnic, for five and a half dollars it's possible to dine on a choice of four entrees plus fresh vegetables nibblers served in a basket with a flower pot full of cheese dip; vegetable soup from the cauldron; homebaked beans, also from the fire (as much as you want): stovie potatoes; cheese bread; ice cream and butter tart, and lots of tea or coffee.

He said many people don't pay much attention to candidates until voting day. A person's vote might well be determined by occupation, he believes.

He said the province told him the Association of Municipalities asked for the ballot change but after examining the recommendations he discovered all the province was asked to do was

keep politicians from listing they hold, such as mayor or their occupation as the office councillor.






