Lawyer Aldo Braida explained that over the years as the Duvals and Papillons divided their jointly held land and later sold other pieces of adjacent property to various parties defects developed in

The whole chain of events began back in the 1930s and it was thought it was all straightened out in 1967. However errors made in rectifying deeds in 1967 have been uncovered now with the Duval home being sold.

He told the committee he only wanted to make sure everyone involved finally ended up with a correct and clear title to their land.

Cynthia Carson of R.R. 3, Acton, received minor injuries after a one car crash on the Eighth Line on September


