selection anyway.

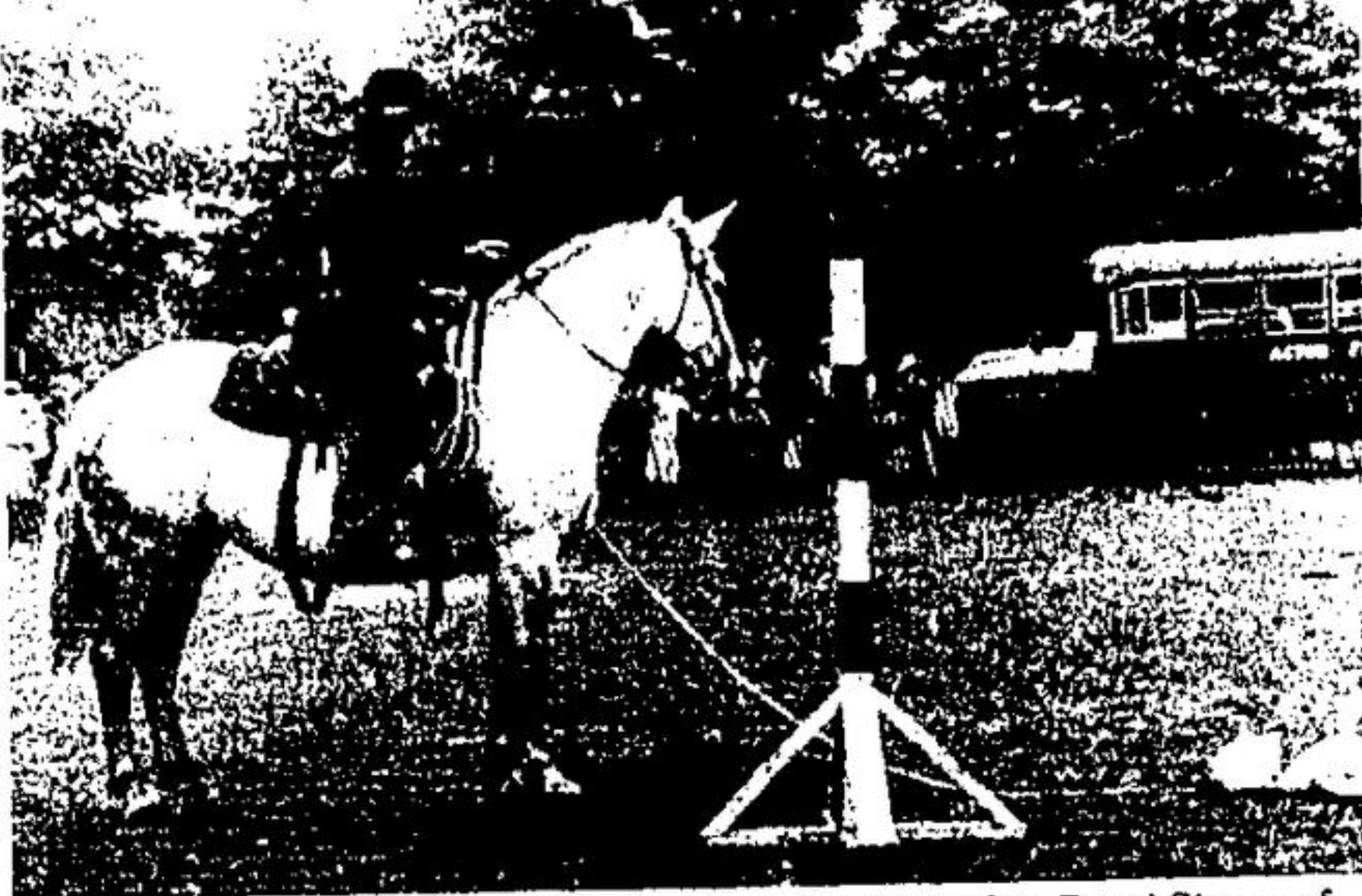
