Sludge topic for meeting

As a result of complaints about sludge from the old Georgetown landfill site, Allan Saunders from the Ministry of the Environment spoke to Halton Hills works committee Monday night. He said he will arrange a meeting with concerned residents in the Ashgrove area to discuss their problems. Sludge and its disposal were the topics at the council meeting for about an hour. The sludge is contracted for hauling and then given free to farmers who want it. Mr. Saunders said if the farmers did not fertilize their fields with sludge, they might find another method of fertilizing that was more objectionable to nearby residents. "How do you keep everybody happy?" Councillor George Maltby wondered if the farmers

could be required to cover the sludge up quickly. Referring to regulations and mentioning leaf burning councillor Doby complained, "The ministry is causing a lot of problems to solve a few problems." Mr. Saunders promised to report back after meeting with Ashgrove people.
