A young Norval man captured the North American Karate and Kung-Fu Open Championships over the weekend in Buffalo, New York. Bill Pickells took the black belt karate division, the toughest competition while Russ Miller, 28 Shelley Street Georgetown, took second in the green belt fighting division. Pickells, who is 24, said the competition is something like a figure skating competition in which the individual does a routine and then is marked by a panel of judges. He has been practicing karate for seven-and-a-half years. His feat in Buffalo was just another in a long line of accomplishments. In the last 18 months Pickells has won 27 trophies. He has also captured a number of major championships in the last two months. Pickells recently captured third place in a competition in St. Petersburg Florida, where there were competitors from six countries and 28 states. He will go to the United States Open Championships in Miami, Florida, soon. He runs the Northern Karate School in Brampton. Pickells started in the sport because it was something different from the usual team sports. He explains that while he has participated in team sports he wants to do it on his own if he's going to win. "I got hooked on karate. It's good for you, mentally and physically. It helped me mature and changes your character," he says. Pickells holds a second degree black belt. Miller is 26 and has been taking karate for over three years.
