**Arthur Meunier asks for money, bedding**

Arthur Meunier, the 41 year prisoner who lives on John St., is appealing for funds and bedding since he has several boys living with him now. He said a couple of the local youths are working and others looking for work. They are 16 to 18 years of age. Two of them had been sleeping for two days in the back seat of a car.

Mr. Meunier says he is supporting the boys in his apartment on his pension of \$236 a month.

Mr. Meunier has just returned from a trip to Winnipeg which he says was very successful. He is applying for a million dollars from the Manitoba government, he said. He reports he has been given 60 acres of land at Lac du Bonnet and an eight acre commercial site in Winnipeg. He will open a satellite Boys' Town in Manitoba, but headquarters will be at Acton, he says.

Mr. Meunier also would like to open arcades in both Acton and Winnipeg.

He expects to leave soon to visit Boys Town in Omaha, Nebraska.

**Improve Bell service 10-on-line days end**

The days of eight or 10 parties on one telephone line are almost over in the Milton and Campbellville exchanges, W.C. Barnes, local Bell Canada manager said today.

A four-year, \$500 million program is now underway throughout Bell Canada territory to introduce a four-party maximum service on rural lines and make available private or two-party service to most customers in the rural areas.

Conversion to the improved service in the Milton and Campbellville exchanges is scheduled to take place Dec. 7, Mr. Barnes said. The local work has cost Bell Canada \$495,000.

As of Dec. 7, multi-party customers will have a basic rate increase and one and two-party customers outside the built-up area will have mileage charges increased.

The monthly rate for four-party service within Milton and Campbellville exchanges will be \$4.60, Mr. Barnes said.

When the conversion is complete, only two of the four phones on a four-party line would ring when an incoming call is received.

Nearly 400 workers at Oakville's Ford plant will be laid off by January 9. Many Halton Hills residents work at the auto manufacturing plant.

A slow assembly line caused by insufficient facilities and stoppages is blamed for the layoffs.

The plant had been turning out 1,060 cars and vans daily but that figure will be trimmed back to 900 a day.
