### Board won't join

Fearing the setting of a precedent, Halton Board of Education rejected a suggestion from Trustee Florence Meares that the public school system join the Halton Youth Services Network.

The youth services network is designed to work with community agencies resolving gaps and duplications of service.

Facing a 1978 budget deficit the Youth Services Network asked the board to take out a membership.

It was noted in Miss Meares' report to the board that the full time co-ordinator of the network is spending one day each week assisting youth groups in North Halton and that a group in Acton is working on setting up a youth centre.

Membership for the board would have cost \$40 a year.

### Town badges up in price

The cloth municipal badge which anyone can buy has gone up in price. It will be raised from 35 cents to 75 cents, if Halton Hills council accepts a finance committee recommendation.

The price went up when it was discovered it was costing 25 cents to invoice them and they were selling for 35 cents.

#### The Assessment Act

## NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS AND TENANTS

As a result of a delay in the passage of recent amendments to The Assessment Act, the normal return of the assessment rolls in municipalities and localities in Ontario will be delayed.

The Honourable Margaret Scrivener, Minister of Revenue, has therefore extended to January 19, 1978, the date upon which the annual assessment roll is returned in all municipalities and localities in Ontario, EXCEPT those municipalities located in The Regional Municipality of Waterloo where the day upon which the assessment roll is returned will be extended to March 16, 1978.

This extension affects the time period during which owners and tenants may appeal their assessments. As a result, the final date for lodging a complaint with the Assessment Review Court in respect of any assessment contained in the assessment rolls is extended from January 19, 1978 to February 9, 1978. In The Regional Municipality of Waterloo the date for lodging a complaint has been extended to April 7, 1978.
