Storm cause GO problems

Last week's two big snowstorms caused a few problems for Georgetown GO trains and GO bus riders. Trains were cancelled last Monday, Thursday and Friday.

The first train out of Union station last Monday arrived in Georgetown late. Its engine broke down at Parkdale and the train sat on the track (idle until the second Georgetown bound train arrived to give it a push to Georgetown).

Thursday's 5:20 train to Georgetown was cancelled. It was slow coming back from Pickering.

Friday only three of the four trains to Georgetown ran because one couldn't get out of Union station because of the derailment on the West Lakeshore route.

There was also a mix-up with the one train being cancelled and many Georgetown passengers thought all the trains were cancelled.

These passengers showed up at the York Mills bus depot trying to catch buses back home.

The sudden influx of extra passengers forced GO to lay on extra buses and even a Toronto Transit Commission bus was pressed into service. The three Georgetown
