

77 LEGAL NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS FOR APPROVAL OF A BY-LAW TO REGULATE LAND USE PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 35 OF THE PLANNING ACT

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills intends to apply to The Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 35 of The Planning Act for approval of by-law 77-84 passed on the 7th day of November, 1977. A copy of the by-law is furnished herewith. A note giving an explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law and stating the lands affected thereby is also furnished herewith.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS BY-LAW NO. 77-84 A by-law to amend By-law 74-51, as amended, of the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills.

WHEREAS the matters herein set out are in conformity with an amendment to the Official Plan of the Esqueping Planning Area which has been adopted and approved and is in force at this time;

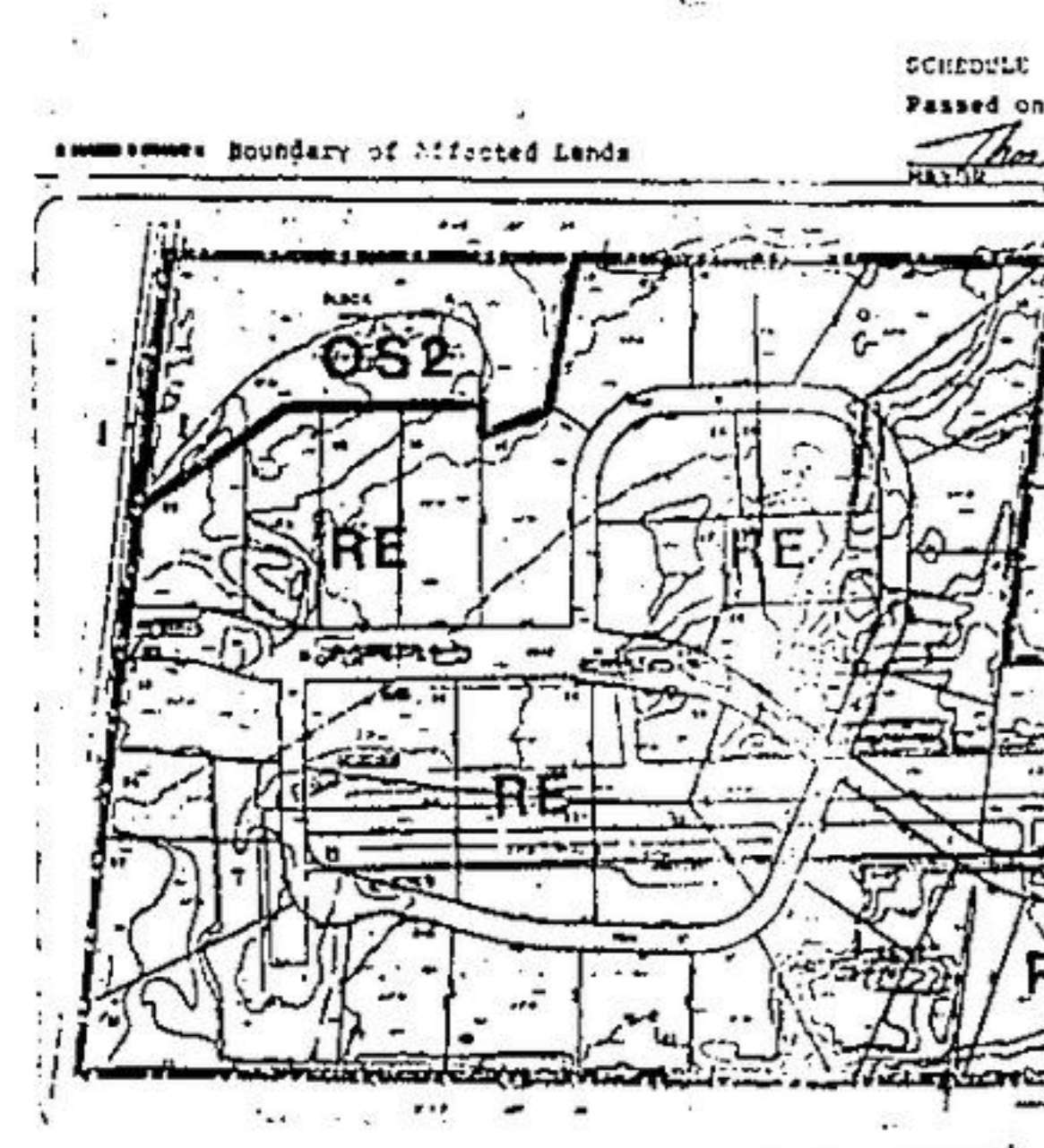
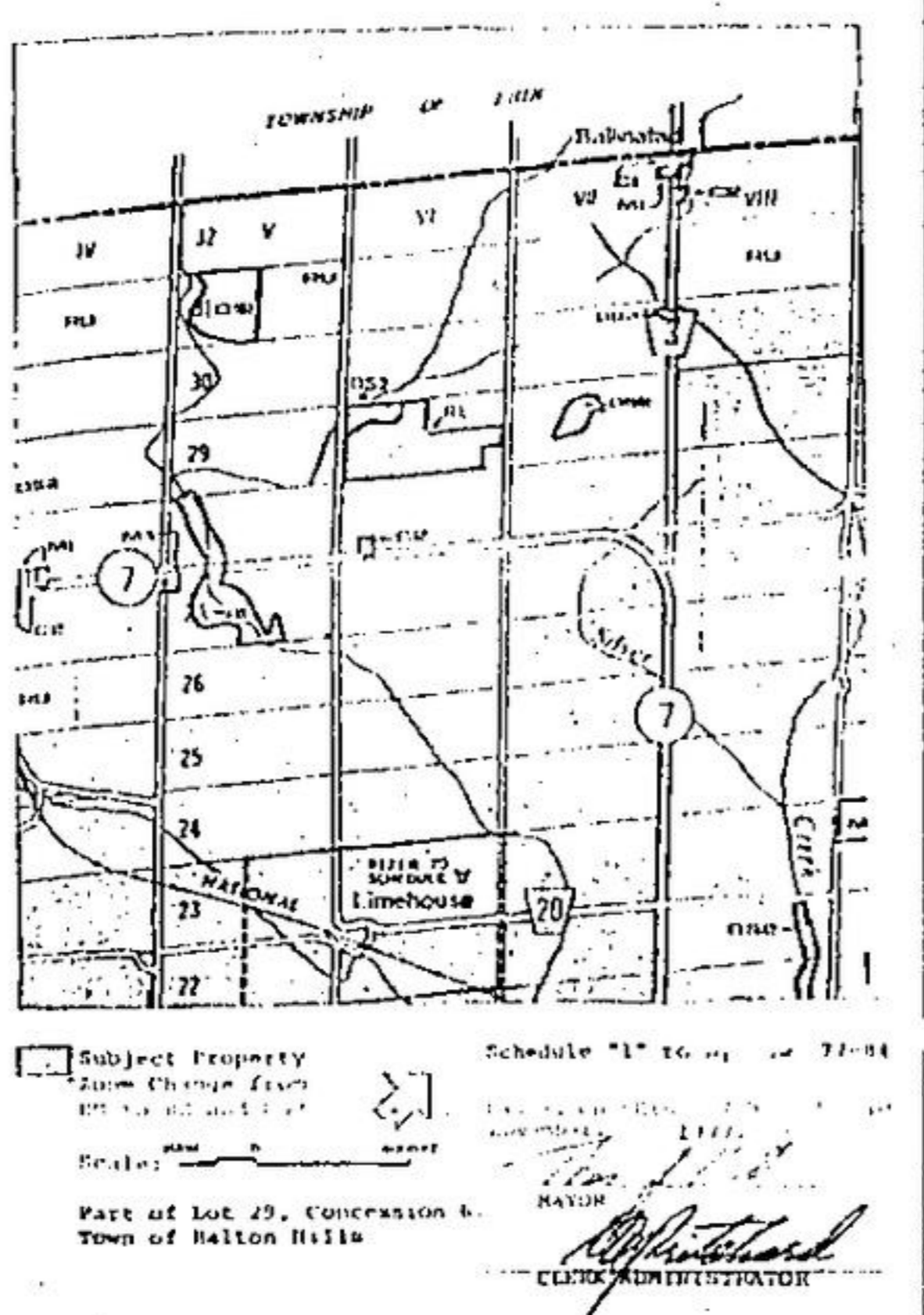
NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Subsection 7.3 - Estate Residential RE Zone - be amended by deleting the sentence "No land is presently zoned as Estate Residential RE Zone" and by substituting therefor the following: "7.3.1. Permitted Uses No person shall within any RE Zone use any lot or erect, alter or use any building or structure for any purpose except one of the following uses, namely: (a) Residential - single family detached dwelling"

- (b) in the column headed "FRONTAGE" the number "200"; (c) in the column headed "AREA" the number "2"; (d) in the column headed "MAXIMUM LOT COVERAGE" the number "15"; (e) in the column headed "FRONT" the number "50"; (f) in the column headed "INTERIOR SIDE" the number "15"; (g) in the column headed "EXTERIOR SIDE" the number "25"; (h) in the column headed "REAR" the number "75"; (i) in the column headed "1-STORY" the number "1800"; (j) in the column headed "1 1/2-STORY" the number "1800"; (k) in the column headed "2-STORY" the number "1800"; (l) in the column headed "MAXIMUM BUILDING HEIGHT" the number "35"; 4. That Schedule "B" be amended by changing the zone designation of those lands shown as Lots 1 to 63 on a plan of subdivision of part of Lot 29, Concession 6, Town of Halton Hills, attached as Schedule "2" to this by-law, from Rural RU Zone to Estate Residential RE Zone.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS Amendment to By-law 74-51 by-law 77-84 EXPLANATORY NOTE Council for The Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills deems it advisable to amend the former Township of Esqueping zoning by-law (By-law 74-51) by changing the zone designation of the lands shown on Schedule "1" to by-law 77-84 from Rural (RU) to Estate Residential (RE) and Inherent Hazard (OS2) zones.

from Rural (RU) zone to Inherent Hazard (OS2) zone. Basically these uses are restricted to existing uses, along with buildings or structures for the purposes of flood and erosion control with the prior approval of the Credit Valley Conservation Authority. Schedule "2" to by-law 77-84 sets out in detail the lot configuration for the property which is to be designated Estate Residential (RE) zone. Schedule "2" also shows the proposed road pattern for the Estate Residential subdivision.

Halton Board defers decision on French program

Halton Board of Education has deferred a vote on expansion of the elementary French language program until the January 28 meeting. Trustees agreed to defer a vote on the controversial question after much discussion Thursday when they were told provincial funds for the program had not been received and a delegation is expected at this Thursday's meeting from Halton Parents for French Immersion.

The board is not sure whether funds from the Province for the program are part of their present grants or an extension to them. Guidelines from the Ministry now allow the board \$54 per student for 20 minutes of French daily. That would increase to \$70 per pupil for 20 minutes and \$110 for 40 minutes of French daily under the new policy.

Bruce Mather, defending the expansion. Lawson fears the core program in the schools will be affected by taking time away from such subjects as mathematics and English. Trustee Edna Robinson says the program is half-baked because it takes 13 teachers out of instruction to provide French instruction. She said she supported French instruction but not under those terms. She felt the administration should come forward and say they needed 13 more teachers for the program and ask if the board was prepared to support it.

what goes on in the battlefield where teaching goes on to get sufficient knowledge of its value, he said. He felt the board was being led down the garden path by the administration. Director of Education Em Lavender admitted the expanded French program would take time from other programs but he also explained that research data from other places where expanded French programs are in use showed no adverse effect on other subjects. He also noted that classes in Halton schools are half-hour longer than legislation calls for.

Board approves radios, rejects transportation officer

Halton Board of Education approved new safety guidelines for school buses including a program to equip the buses with two way radios. However the Board turned down a recommendation to hire a transportation officer at a salary of \$20,000 a year.

Mr. Lawson said he stood firm on his concerns despite a lengthy report from the superintendent of Program Hinton maintained it was discriminatory because all drivers in the East area of Halton had that training. East area buses are operated by the Halton Board.

Halton principal acquitted of marijuana trafficking

A Halton elementary school principal was acquitted in provincial court last week of charges of possession of marijuana for the purpose of trafficking. A principal for 14 years in Halton who was moved from his principality of a Burlington school last September and given an administrative job with Halton Board of Education, Robert Gordon Kearns was charged after police found 11 marijuana plants growing in his backyard.

Richardson was sentenced to one day in jail and fined \$500. Kearns was also remanded to February 11 for trial on a charge that he unlawfully possessed a quantity of Chloridazepoxide pills for the purpose of sale under the provisions of the Food and Drug Act.

Eight Oakville parents object to French Immersion

A group of Oakville parents-eight in total-are opposed to a French Immersion program being implemented by the Halton Board of Education. "We feel a program (French Immersion) which has so little interest shown in it (4.5 per cent) should not become a burden to the taxpayers in this region".

When Kearns was charged with the marijuana offence Trustee Bert Hinton, Acton-Esqueping, tried to have him suspended until the case was settled but the board decided just to move him out of his school and into a less sensitive position in the administration. Harley Lishman, operations superintendent, noted the board had a transportation officer until 1972 when bus supervisor Ken Giles retired.

Later Mr. Hinton told the press he thought Mr. Venditti would be helpful to the board in efforts to acquire new school sites at costs much lower than they were paying now.
