What does a chiropractor do in his spare time? If he's anything like Acton's newest doctor, he won't have much time to worry about it. W.R.T. (Tom) Thompson opened his new business February 1, but is continuing his Toronto practice at the same time. He alternates mornings and afternoons, giving him little time to enjoy his hobbies.

continued to say that there will be a run on back pains or shoulder and neck pains, and even headaches. Pain, numbness, loss of feeling or the disfunction of a body organ or part can be symptoms.

Dr. Thompson says, people decide to garden or paint or do exercises, and they find they are in pain. His objective, he stated, is to try to differentiate what is the cause and what is the complaint.

After growing up in Toronto, Dr. Thompson and his wife decided to leave the hustle and bustle of city living behind and move to Ospringe. He still commuted daily. Four years later, Dr. Thompson decided to open up shop in Acton, and chose the Alteo Building, 103 Main St. N. for his office. However, he decided to continue working in Toronto also. Now, the mornings of Monday, Wednesday and Friday he spends in his Acton office, and the afternoons in Toronto. Tuesday and Thursday afternoons are also spent in Acton, with the mornings in Toronto.

His office is made up of three working rooms, an x ray room, with the latest of equipment, and the reception area. His love of antiques will soon be obvious in this area when he buys the furniture he wants. Dr. Thompson's other hobby is ducks. He belongs to the club Ducks Unlimited, a private non-profit conservation organization engaged in the development and preservation of prime waterfowl breeding habitat in Canada. Acton's Fairy Lake ducks had no bearing on his decision to open a practice here, but it is a very definite bonus, he says.

Dr. Thompson graduated from the Canadian Memorial Chiropractic College in Toronto and has worked in Etobicoke for seven years. His job involves working with people who have structural problems that interfere with the nervous system. Some people, he explained, have acute injury, which is the result of occupational stress or accident. Some people, he continued, have chronic problems suffering from long-standing illnesses. Dr. Thompson can provide the necessary relief to allow the patient to carry on life. Sometimes, he stated just exercises, nutritional guidance and checkups are all that is necessary. If the cause of the physical problem is structural, the best way to deal with it is to approach the cause.

A lot of people, Dr. Thompson claimed, think they have to be referred to his office by a medical doctor. That is not the case, he said, although a lot of his patients are referrals. OHIP pays for a portion of the costs. The most common reason for visits to the chiropractor is pain. Dr. Thompson explained that complaints vary from week to week, and a lot come at the same time.
