A unique experience is to take place in the Georgetown Fairground Saturday, June 3—a festival of the arts—SUMMERFEST '78.

Halton Hills Arts Council is sponsoring an opportunity for the many and varied art forms of Halton to come together to display, demonstrate, sell and entertain the public.

Throughout the day, musical presentations will be made by the Georgetown Choral Society as well as the Georgetown High School Band, the Georgetown Girls Pipe Band, a number of folk singing groups and a rock group also from the high school. Highland dancers and a senior ballet class will also be performing.

Phil Sykes and his music will be featured in a two hour concert to be held in the evening.

The Georgetown Little Theatre has already started rehearsals for three performances to be put on throughout the day.

A number of marquees will house a variety of activities to appeal to all interests and ages. Arts and crafts, in the form of paintings, pottery, photograph, knitting, woodwork, batik and much more, will be displayed and sold by local individual artists and art groups; for example, the Credit Valley Artisans, the Arts and Crafts of Georgetown, the Georgetown Weaver's Guild and the Palette and Pencil Club. The Esqueing Historical Society, the Horticultural Society and the Conservation Centre, to name a few, have also reserved display areas.

Opening ceremonies will begin at 1 p.m. with MP Julian Reed, Mr. Wm. Kriesel, a representative of the Ministry of Culture and Recreation, and other dignitaries.

Of course with every festival, refreshments will be available throughout the day; for example, bake goods, candy apples, and snack bar items, all of which can be enjoyed at picnic facilities. A beer garden will also be set up in the Armories.

With each ticket to Summerfest—50 cents for adults, 25 cents for children 12 and under—there is the opportunity to win a number of door prizes to be drawn at the evening concert. Tickets will be available at local stores and at the gate.

On Sunday, May 28th, at Georgetown's McDonalds, children will have their own artistic talent by painting images of summer on large murals, the best of which will be displayed on June 3. Prizes will be given.
