



## Real Estate New gun laws mainly aimed at irresponsible

are being enforced across Canada in an effort to reduce criminal and other irresponsible use of guns.

The majority of gun owners and users, says a newly issued national pamphlet, Gun Control in Canada, are responsible hunters and target shooters. These prople will continue to enjoy these legitimate pastimes without significant hindrance. "They should, however, be aware of those provisions which involved the safe handling of firearms and effective January 1, 1979, the requirements necessary to obtain a Firearms Acquisition Certificate when purchasing or acquiring firearms," the pamphlet

"Most of the other changes to the gun control laws affect only those persons who use guns in an irresponsible manner causing needless death and injury.
