Canadian Unity

"No Province can be permitted to dictate to the rest of Canada. Our Founding Fathers recognized the importance of all regions and all peoples of Canada. This has not changed. Commitments and problems from Newfoundland to B.C. must be carefully considered. In addition to the French, many cultures make important contributions to the fabric of our Canadian Society. Each of these must be encouraged. Quebec issues are important, difficult and cannot be ignored. If however, Canada is to remain united and strong, no undue concessions should be granted to any Province. The benefits and responsibilities of Confederation must be shared by all Canadians in all regions."

1,000,000 Unemployed

"I am-sick and tired of Trudeau handing out our money on a silver platter to people who are taking advantage of our unemployment and welfare programs. The dollar deficit is staggering. They have taken away our pride by encouraging us to stay at home with payments equal or better than many hard working Canadians. Unemployment Insurance regulations can still be tightened and areas of administration easily improved, WE MUST GIVE CANADIANS BACK THEIR PRIDE."

Small Business

'Businesses, and particularly small businesses, should be given the incentives to expand so they can provide more jobs for people in every area of Canada. Small business employs 65% of our working people and the very heart of our economy. Policy measures have an important role to play and must be carefully designed and co-ordinated. This is both a long and short term problem. We urge the establishment of a Small Business Secretariat which would function independently from the Dept. of Industry, Trade and Commerce. Small business has been ignored too long. Don't punish success. Let's free Enterprise."

Civil Service — Bureaucracy

"In 10 years, the Trudeau Government increased federal spending by 460%. The Prime Minister's own office staff tripled from 40 to 120. There are now 30 government departments to interfere with everything from amateur sport to vacation travel. Armies of tax gatherers. form collectors, regulators, inspectors, social activists and the rest have made Canada the most over-governed country in the western world. We must reduce the civil service, discontinue indexing civil service and M.P. pensions. We must discontinue costly, inflationary temporary make-work problems. We must discontinue unproductive special grants to privileged groups in and out of Canada. We must streamline the Unemployment Insurance policies. In short, government interference must be reduced in the private sector."

Law and Order

"Canada is fortunate that public attitudes and efficient and highly-motivated police forces such as the R.C.M.P. have created a country where the streets are safe. There is a strong danger that this happy situation is beginning to grode because of government interference, and excessive leniency towards law breakers. Potential law breakers must be made aware that the law is swift and severe and police forces must be given the freedom needed to control crime."

Government Spending

"Albeit essential to the Canadian economy and practical functioning of our country to maintain a high profile and active civil service, the unessential and unprofitable aspects of government bureaucracy must be reduced whenever and wherever possible. Many government agencies could easily be disbanded and their work passed over to private enterprise thereby encouraging the initiation and expansion of the private business sector."

Capital Punishment

"I think it is a damn shame that the murderers of young Emanuel Jaques will be allowed to roam our streets in approximately 20 years. One of them even said they might not have committed the "sickening" crime, if capital punishment was still in existence. Indexed Pensions
