

A MAN OF ACTION HALTON RIDING NEEDS OTTO!

Hansard Reprints From Jelinek Speeches And Questions In The House Of Commons Form A Thick Book!

During his six years in Ottawa, Otto Jelinek has become one of the best known members of the Opposition through his continual questioning of the operations of the Liberal government.

Here are just a few of the issues he has raised:

JUNE 1976 — Otto Jelinek demanded that the elected representatives of the people vote in accord with the wishes of their constituents for the retention of capital punishment.

FEB. 15, 1978 — Otto Jelinek suggested that minister of labor concentrate on Canada's woeful strike and walkout problem instead of spending his time on the change of ownership of the Hamilton Tiger-Cats.

DEC. 12, 1977 — Otto Jelinek asked that the Postmaster General investigate that only 10 per cent of the postal workers eligible took part in a strike vote which favored a labor stoppage.

DEC. 7, 1977 — Otto Jelinek moved in the house that the Minister for Small Business and the Minister of Finance be instructed to develop special programs to assist small business.

NOV. 7, 1977 — Otto Jelinek moved a vote of confidence in rank and file members of the RCMP after Premier Rene Levesque had referred to the RCMP as "jerks".

OCT. 24, 1977 — Otto Jelinek asked that the government table testimony from the secret trial of communications engineer Peter Treu who was tried under the War Secrets Act.

OCT. 19, 1977 — Otto Jelinek objected to the fact that the Throne speech had made no reference to small business in Canada.

And the list goes on and on.

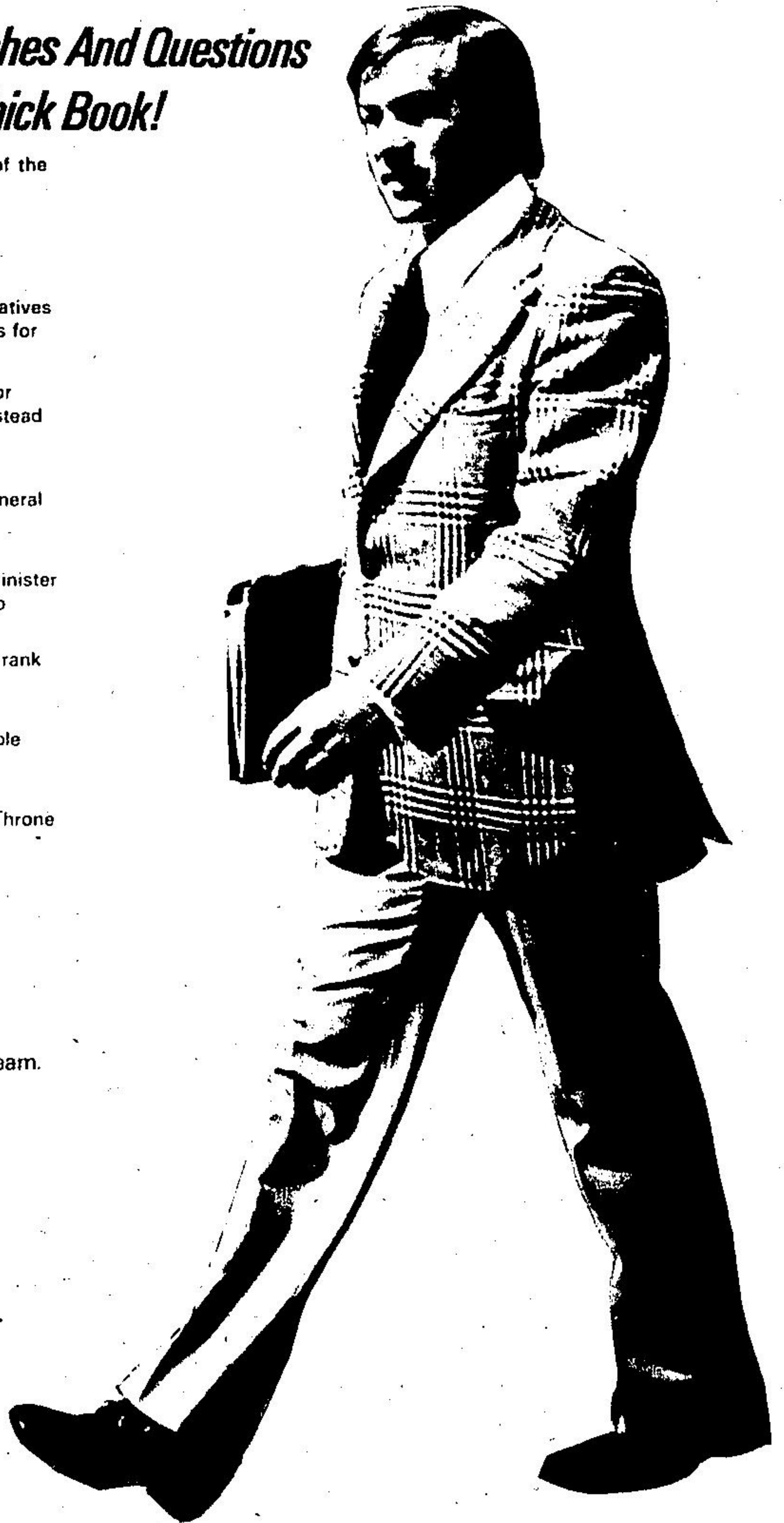
