Firm fears loss of deal

A Campbellville firm is tendering on a \$250,000 federal government contract though the plans it received were written in French.

The firm, Pro-Eng Building Ltd., fears it may lose the contract, 12 other companies are bidding, because it is not bilingual.

"How can you put in an English contract, if the specifications and drawings are in French," asks Pro-Eng vice-President Colin Davis.

The contract is for the building of shelters for French West Africa.

Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) spokesman Peter Haines told Davis that an English translation would be too costly, and that the African country demanded the specs be written in French.
