Ontario's early Victorian history is sumptuous at heritage homes

Take a drive almost any. where in Ontario and you're sure to find evidence of our history in abundance. And, thankfully, many of the province's historic buildings retain their character to show visitors the life, times and atmosphere of eras gone

For most pioneering families, life was rugged. Politican and environmental hardships abounded but, in a handful of households, life was leisurely, sumptuous and the stuff of which dreams are made.

Dundurn Castle in Hamilton represents the epitome of that more graceful lifestyle.

Billed Canada's AB largest restored Victorian monsion, Dundurn was built in 1834 for Sir Allan MacNab, prime minister of the Province of Canada between 1854 and 1856. The startling opulence of mid-1800's comes vividly alive in each of Dundurn's more than 30 refurbished rooms.

Without dispute, the massive drawing room is the crowning jewel. Rich reds, pinks and mauves so beloved by the Victorians give carpets and drapes an unforgettable brilliance when set amongst many of Sir Allan's original furnishings.

The dining room, complete with fine silver, china, crystal and a ten-legged dining table, can easily conjure visions of Sir Allan plotting the effective demise of William Lyon Mackenzie's rebellion of


But Dundurn offers more than a singular view of those times. Downstairs sets the domestic scene for the castle, Bread and beer are still baked and brewed in the enormous kitchen and smaller brewery. Dozens of bells still hand in the kitchen to summon long-gone servants to various rooms. Your imagination will be unleashed in any room, on any visit.

Further west in London, Ontario, the home of Sir . Allan's contemporary, John Harris, shows a different view of Victorian life in our emerging country.

Smaller by far than Dundurn, Harris' Eldon House is no less interesting.

The oldest surviving private home in the city, Eldon House was built the same year as Dundurn and housed four generations of the Harris family until it was deeded to London in

The home is filled with 125 years of a family's past from beautiful Canadian, English and Chinese furniture to momentos of African safaris to a most (Continued on Page 9)






