## Minor hockey revamps 500

## Town buys new ice resurfacer

Acton Minor Hockey has revamped its 500 Club for next season's draws.

There will be \$4,500 given away over the 30 week period. Each Saturday there will be the same number of draws, five, but prize money for each will be increased from \$10 to \$30.

The grand prize for the draw this time around will be two weeks in Hawaii. Second prize will be two weeks in Florida. The only stipulations are that the trip must be taken by December 1, 1979. The draw will likely take place in the latter part of May or June. Travel arrangements will be made through Ted Tyler Travel Agency.

The membership structure will also be changed slightly. Instead of \$1 for 30 weeks the Acton Minor Hockey 500 Club will ask for \$10 when the ticket is bought and two post-dated cheques for November 11 and January 27.

On the final night of the draws the grand prize receives 100 and \$50 respectively.

A positive date for the first of the 30 draws has not yet been set.

Councillor Peter Morris pointed out no more tending is necessary since bids were received from the only three companies in the business.

Russ Miller said the Olympia costs \$1,000 more than the lowest tender, but said that company had not been in business very long. On the advice of the arena manager and the recreation department, the committee recommended the Olympia.
