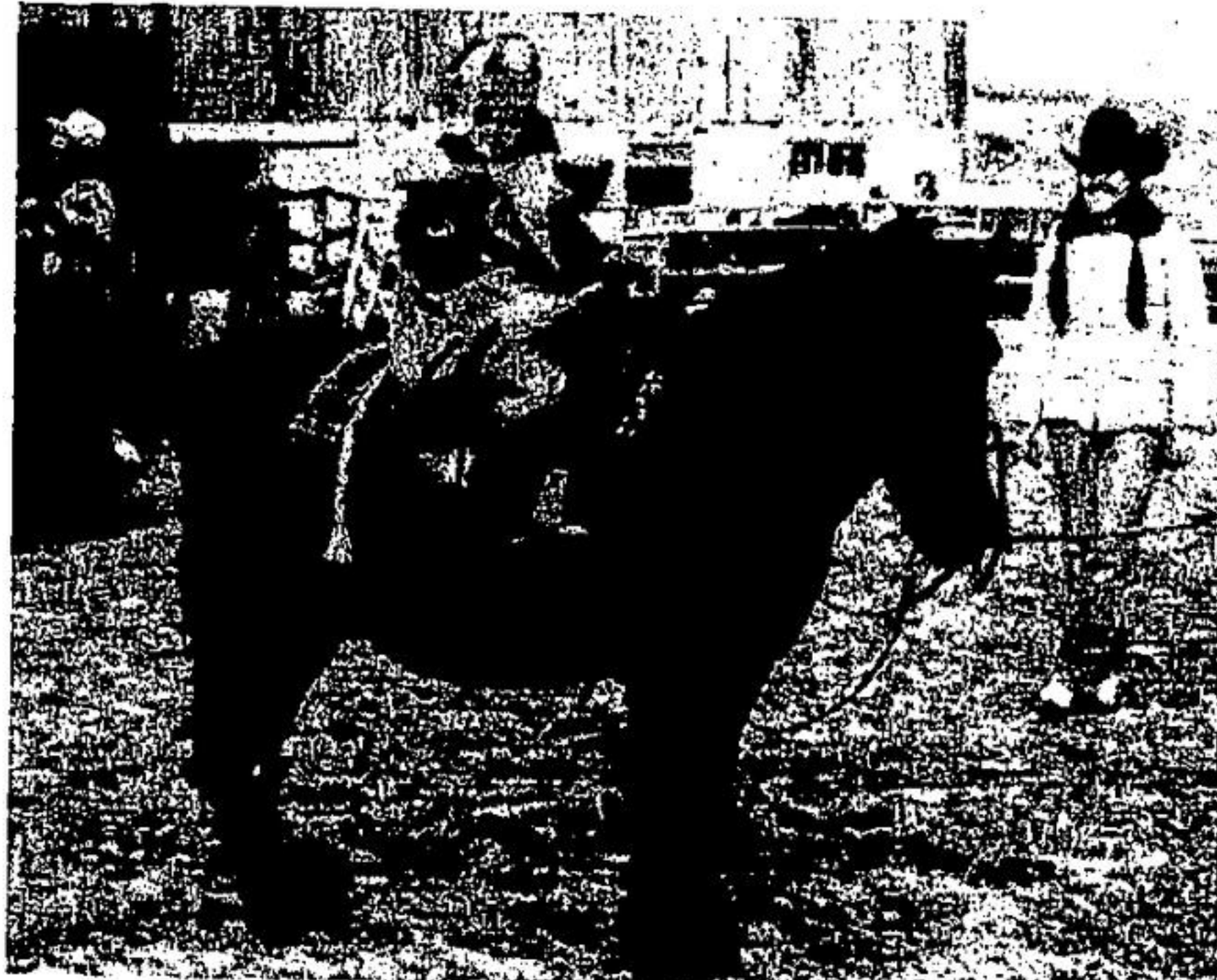
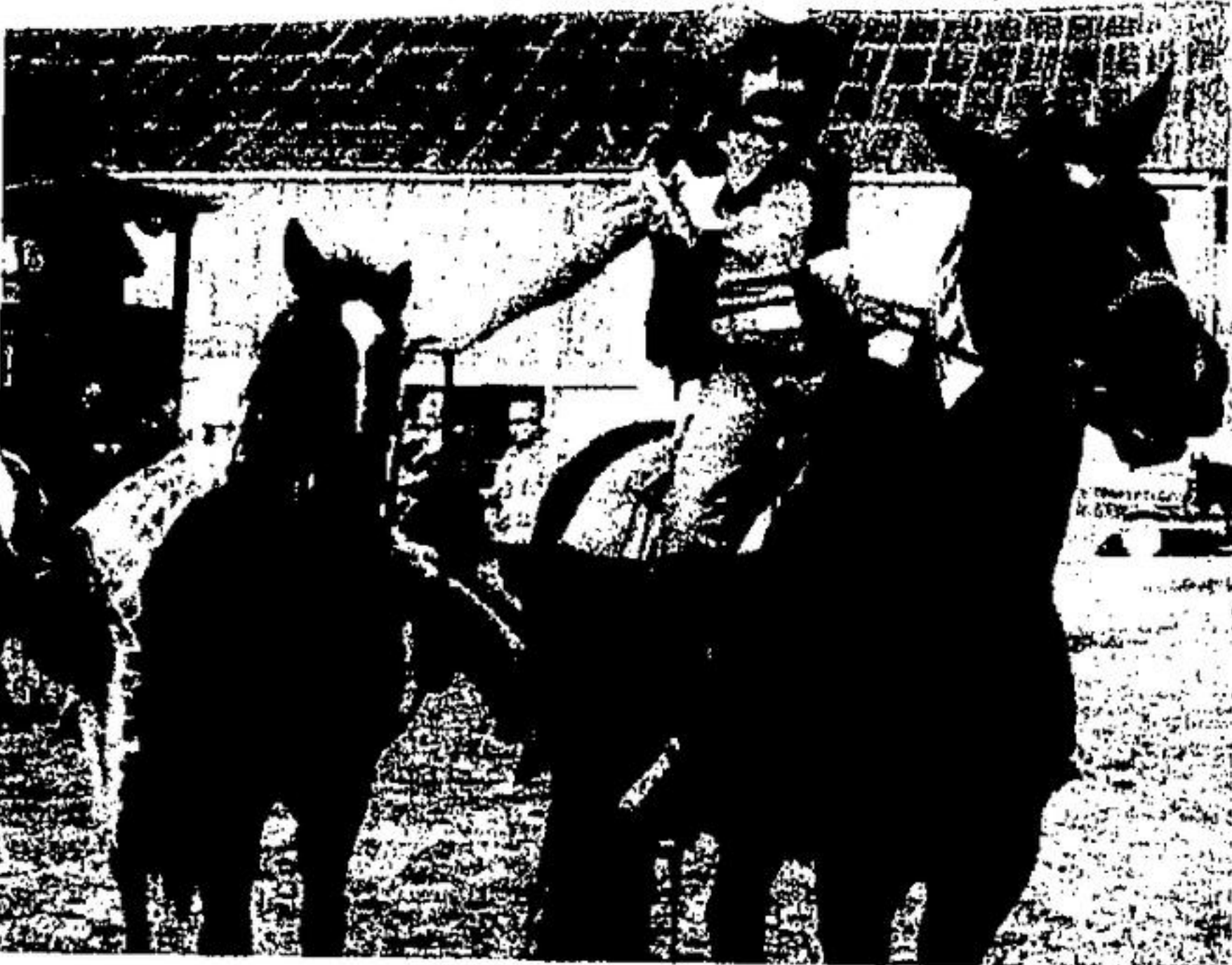


Trail Riders fun day casual show for juniors

1978 MUNICIPALITY AND SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

Notice is hereby given that Candidates may be Nominated for the following offices by filing with the Returning Officer at the Town of Milton Municipal Offices, 251 Main Street East, Milton, Ontario, during his normal office hours, a Nomination Paper in the prescribed form:

Such Nomination Paper shall be filed during the period commencing on:

MONDAY, OCTOBER 16th, 1978 through to FRIDAY, OCTOBER 20th, 1978 Between the HOURS of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

and on:

MONDAY, OCTOBER 23rd, 1978 Between the HOURS of 8:30 to 5:00 p.m.

Nominations may be filed for the following offices:

THE TOWN OF MILTON

Mayor -- To be elected at large and serve as a member on both the Regional and Town Councils.

2 Councillors -- To serve on both the Regional and Town Councils. One Such Councillor to be elected from the combined Wards 1 (Trafalgar), and 3 (Nassagaweya), and 1 such Councillor to be elected from Ward 2 (Milton).

8 Councillors -- To serve on the Town Council only. 2 such Councillors to be elected from Ward 1 (Trafalgar), 4 such Councillors to be elected from Ward 2 (Milton), and 2 such Councillors to be elected from Ward 3 (Nassagaweya).

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON

2 Members -- 1 such Member to be elected by Public School Supporters from the combined Wards 1 (Trafalgar) and 3 (Nassagaweya) and 1 such Member to be elected from Ward 2 (Milton).

1 Member -- To be elected by Roman Catholic Separate School Supporters from the Combined Municipalities of Halton Hills and Milton.

NOTE: As the Town of Milton is combined with the Town of Halton Hills to elect one Member to the Board of Education for the Regional Municipality of Halton to represent Roman Catholic Separate School Supporters in the respective Municipalities, Nominations for Candidates for the said Member will be received by the Returning Officer of the Corporation of the Town of Milton at the Milton Municipal Offices, 251 Main Street East, Milton, Ontario, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, October 16, 1978 to October 20, 1978 and on Monday, October 23, 1978 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC SCHOOL BOARD FOR THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON

1 Member -- To be elected at large from the Combined Wards 1 (Trafalgar), 2 (Milton), and 3 (Nassagaweya).

All of the above offices are for a Two Year Term. Candidates are required to submit Nominations on the prescribed form only. Such forms may be obtained from the Office of the Returning Officer, Town of Milton, Municipal Offices, 251 Main Street, East, Milton, Ontario, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, October 16th, 1978 to October 20th, 1978, and 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 23rd, 1978 only.

Notice is also given that the Municipal Elections Act, 1977 provides that a Nomination Paper:

(a) Shall be signed by at least ten electors whose names are entered, or are eligible to be entered subject to the necessary affidavit, in the polling lists of electors entitled to vote in an election to such office;

(b) Shall state the name, and address of the Candidate in such a manner as will identify him and the office for which he is nominated; and

(c) Shall state the name and address of each elector signing the nomination paper and, where the office for which the candidate is nominated is a public school elector or a separate school elector, as the fact is; and

Take notice that the nomination paper shall state for which office and in which ward or area, except those running at large, the candidate is proposing to be nominated. And further take notice that where the candidate is running in a ward or area his nomination paper must be signed by people on the Polling List of Electors in that specific ward or area.

And further take notice the onus is on the person nominated for election to an office to file a bona fide nomination paper.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON APPOINTMENT OF VOTING PROXY

Any person whose name is entered on the polling list for a polling subdivision or who has obtained a certificate to be included on the list in the municipality and who is,

- A person other than one who is in a hospital or other institution, where a polling place has been provided on such premises for the purpose of polling or where provision has been made to attend upon such persons for the purpose of receiving their ballot, and
- A person who is certified by a legally qualified medical practitioner, by a certificate filed with the Clerk, to be physically incapable of attending a polling place;
- A person absent from his regular residence by reason of attending an educational institution and expects by reason of such absence from the municipality to be unable to vote at the advance poll or on polling day; or
- A person who expects to be absent from his polling subdivision during the election period including the advance poll and polling day by reason of his being engaged for hire or reward in the business of transportation by railway, air, water or motor vehicle,

may, on forms obtainable at the Office of the Returning Officer, 251 Main Street East, Milton, appoint any person to vote in his stead who is entitled to vote in the same municipality.

Such persons must be appointed and certified by the Clerk of the Municipality during the period following nomination day (Friday, October 23rd, 1978 to 5:00 p.m. on polling day Monday, November 13, 1978.)
