## Nominate a tree

If there a large tree in your backyard, or at the cottage? If so, it may be eligible for nomination to the Honour Roll of Ontario Trees.

The Honour Roll of Ontario Trees is a listing maintained by the Ontario Forestry Association of the largest reported specimens of both native and a limited number of introduced species in the province.

Launched by Albert Butwick of Millgrove, Ontario as a Centennial project, the first list was published in 1974. The current list has 105 trees.

In submitting nominations for the roll, precise location along with photos or slides needs to be included along with information on the species, size, age, condition, history and a general description of the tree.

## Halton Hills home for Black Walnut

Ontario's largest Black Walnut tree is growing in Halton Hills. Halton Field Naturalists learned last week.

Guest speaker Albert Butwick, an amateur dendrologist (one who studies trees or that part of botany which treats of trees) told about 40 club members of the Black Walnut (Juglans nigra) and about 96 other species of trees on the Honour Roll of Ontario Trees.

A pipe fitter at the Dofasco steel plant in Hamilton Butwick, took on the project of finding the largest and tallest trees, both native and introduced species, in Ontario as a centennial project 11 years ago.

With his collection of 125 color slides, which he estimated took 15 years to gather, he informed the Halton Field Naturalists of some of the fascinating history behind some of Ontario's most outstanding trees.

For instance, he showed a slide of a Maple tree, which appeared much like any other Maple tree until he pointed out it was the very one from which a leaf fell and inspired the composer of The Maple Leaf Forever.

Another slide showed what remains of the original McIntosh apple tree. He told members of the club it was the only survivor of 20 trees found growing abandoned and transplanted by the man who gave his name to the distinctive tasting apple.

The Black Walnut in Halton Hills has a girth of 17 feet at a distance of four and a half feet above the ground and a diameter of 65 inches. It is 86 feet high and has an average crown spread of 90 feet. It is located on private property near Hwy. 7 and the Seventh Line.

Butwick, 52, has turned his property at Millgrove, north of Hamilton, into an arboretum where he is growing 78 of the 84 trees and shrubs which grow in Ontario. He's been interested in trees since about 1950.

"I wish I'd got on it a lot sooner," he said in an interview. "It takes time to grow trees."

Butwick was honored with a Conservation Award in 1978 by the Ontario Federation of Naturalists. He mentioned with a touch of pride that he has also been on television for the Dofasco Illustrated News. However, Butwick indicated he took these honors modestly and said the focus of his talks was to get other persons collecting data about the province's outstanding trees.
