Affluent Oakville tops in income

Oakville once, again has the highest per capita income in Canada, according to figures released by Statistics Canada.

Statistics Canada figures are based on the 1976 year, and show Oakville to have had an average income, based on taxable income returns, of \$16,573 up from \$15,135 of the previous year.

The list of average incomes includes all tax returns, not just those where tax is payable.

Burlington placed second in the 1976 race, with an average income of \$12,702, while Sept Iles was third with \$12,542.

Oakville stretched its lead over Burlington slightly between 1975 and 1976 when the two recorded average incomes of \$11,714 and \$11,527 respectively.
