## Council turns deaf ear to mayor's privacy plea

Invasion of privacy was insufficient reason to convince Halton Regional Council to reject a request by Hamilton-Wentworth Regional Council. The request asks all vehicle registrations in the region, the type of vehicles and the number of automobiles per household be made available to the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

Milton Mayor Don Gordon made the plea, saying the ministry has no right to know how many cars a family owns.

Council's decision was based on the recommendation of the planning committee which had endorsed the Hamilton-Wentworth proposal.

A similar proposal received by the administration committee was received and filed. Other recommendations council approved from the planning committee were:

- permission for Homeco Investments Limited to register a plan on condominiums in Burlington;
- a request of Eagle Holdings Limited for a proposed plan of subdivision in Oakville to be withdrawn as requested by the regional solicitor;
- council act quickly on any future comments from the EEAC such as in the matter of the City of Burlington Tuck Creek Watershed Study;
- the region has no opposition to Amendment 38 in Oakville's official plan;
- a proposed plan of condominium by Treasury Trail Holdings Ltd. in Oakville subject to the condition that sanitary sewers and water mains be installed and completed prior to registration with the Ministry of Housing;
- "That the Ministry of Housing be advised that the Regional Municipality of Halton has no objection to the approval of the proposed official plan amendment 9 to the Acton Planning Area provided that the area is suitably buffered against noise so as to meet the standards of the Ministry of Environment";
- five-year capital forecast of a preliminary nature.

with Nancy Gordon

Dear God:  
In 1959, I had spent an enjoyable evening in Toronto bringing in the New Year with my lady friend. However, being the proprietor of a marina and billiard hall, which was open all night, I had to return to Gravenhurst early.

Around 1:30 in the morning, as I drove north of Barrie on Highway 400, an oncoming vehicle hit us head on, as it passed another car. I was knocked unconscious.

Duke, my much loved German Shepherd, could not understand what had happened. He realized that I was badly hurt and he sat protectively on my chest defying anything or anyone to come near me.

A gun, a police officer, and Duke's head in direct line of fire, was all I could see when I regained consciousness. "Duke," I said, "It's okay. Go with the officer." Realizing the situation, this was all I could manage before I blacked out again. Thank you God for returning my consciousness just in time to save Duke's life.

Although my life had been saved, my nose had been severed. The plastic surgeon had only a small piece of my son and me, which he found in my wallet, to use as a guide to rebuild my nose. The operation was a success and left no noticeable signs or deformity.

In addition to my severed nose the central vertebra had been fractured. This vertebra required chiropractic treatments three times a week in a Toronto clinic for two years. This meant many painful drives from Gravenhurst to Toronto. Thank You God for helping me endure this suffering and pain.

Now I walk well and do many things, but extra exertion means a trip to the chiropractor to manipulate the vertebra in my back which is easily dislodged. Also, nervous tension or worry creates great pain in my chest. Therefore, I must always carry "dynamite pills". However, I am now in my 70's and I am so thankful to be alive, I can walk, drive a car and enjoy life doing everything within limitations.

I am constantly reminded of this accident and the words of the investigating officer who came to see me in the hospital. He stated that it was marvellous to investigate a case where no one was drunk even although the accident was only a few hours after New Year's Eve.

The police officer took Duke home to care for him. His children loved Duke so much that they wanted to keep Duke. While I was in the hospital for four weeks, Duke would not eat and appeared bewildered and lonely. This created quite a problem. Duke's weight dropped from 128 to 85 pounds. Love certainly is the strongest force on earth. When Duke returned home with me he began to eat like a horse and quickly regained his health. Thank You God for being with Duke. We were the closest of companions and he lived through this and for some years after to reach the age of 13 years before You took him home.

Thank You God for on that New Year's Day, I not only began a New Year, but a new chance in life.
