Jenny Kuiken at conference

Building strengths was the theme of a four day conference put on by the Ontario Association for the Mentally Retarded in Kingston May 9 to 13.

Jenny Kuiken, R.R. 2, Acton, was the North Halton Association for the Mentally Retarded representative at the 26th annual conference.

The various groups must build strengths

within their organization for the future of the movement, and to build a future for those who are mentally retarded.

Advocacy was a key issue at the conference. Groups spoke of citizen advocacy, corporate advocacy and self advocacy. All it takes is a little time and a little money to create interest in the mentally retarded. Protection of their rights and how the individuals can achieve this was also discussed.

A one on one situation for the handicapped is a very important part of the learning process, the conference learned. For the mentally retarded person to develop a friend outside his or her family, and the people who are paid to take care of them is a milestone in their lives.

In Listen Please, a special booklet Mrs. Kuiken received at the conference it was pointed out it is possible to take courses on understanding the mentally retarded, and relating to them. Radio, television, and the newspapers are filled with stories, "and yet," the book says, "it is possible to go through 12 grades of public school without having a single meaningful relationship with such a handicapped person. In fact, if one is very careful, it is possible to get a Ph.D. in the field without ever getting close to one."
