



In Listen Please, a special booklet Mrs. Kuiken received at the conference it was pointed out il is possible to take courses on understanding the mentally retarded, and relating to them. Radio, television, and the newspapers are filled with stories, "and yet," the book says, "it is possible to go through 12 grades of public school without having a single meaningful relationship with such a handicapped person. In fact, if one is very careful, it is possible to get a Ph.D. in the field without ever getting close to one."
