Board approves first transport policy

Haltom Board of Education has a transportation policy. The board's first policy, with revisions, received approval Thursday during the board's meeting at Burlington. The board has provided transportation previously in line with the provincial ministry of education's guidelines on bussing.

One theme throughout the 12-page paper is that transportation is a privilege which may be withdrawn at any time. Under the policy parents are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children prior to their being picked-up and also after they leave the bus at the end of the day.

Pupils must obey a code of conduct which includes points that they sit where told by the driver and that they remain seated for the trip. There is to be no smoking, on the bus. Also skates are to be covered by guards. Dangerous or annoying toys are prohibited on buses.

In general these guidelines are used to determine eligibility for transportation service. Children in kindergarten and Grade One, more than a mile (1.6 kilometers), Grades Two to Eight, more than two miles (3.2 kilometers) and from Grades Nine to 13 more than three miles (4.8 kilometers).

In towns where no public transit service exists, school bus transportation may be provided for students who reside beyond the guidelines.

Miller backs down after sludge tour

Haltom Hills Councillor Russ Miller "won't say I'm happy, but I'm not as concerned as I was" about a sludge storage lagoon on the Alex Holmes Farm. Mr. Miller had urged that the region not grant a \$2,000 improvement to the farm occupant so he could expand his sludge pond to accommodate the waste for another five months.

He had charged at the Aug. 8 meeting of the public works committee that the sludge disposal area was "illegal" and had never been licensed by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment although the pond had been in operation for five years.

He told last Wednesday's regular meeting of the committee that he had taken a personal tour of Alex Holmes Farm and had been mollified by what he had observed. "It has been licensed now for two years. I saw the one lagoon which is to be enlarged and there are two future sites.

"We have to get rid of it somewhere," he said.

Mr. Miller said his preliminary objections had been based on complaints about sludge spills onto adjacent properties.

"I'm sure that with regional inspection this will never happen again," he said.

The new policy goes on to state that in the countryside transportation will be provided for all students who live more than a mile by road from the school they attend.

All buses are to be equipped with a two-way radio.

Where possible in rural areas no students will be required to walk more than a mile from their home gate to the bus stop. Also every attempt will be made to ensure Kindergarten and grade one pupils are picked up and dropped as close to their home gates as safety will allow.

Operators have authority to designate bus stops within limits.
