

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

Entries in "full mouth milk teeth" classes must have completed their Record of Performance (ROP) test. Beginning in 1980, all entries will be requested to have completed performance testing.

Prize money for all classes as follows: \$20, \$17, \$14, \$12, \$10, \$8, \$6, \$5, \$4, \$4.

SECTIONS

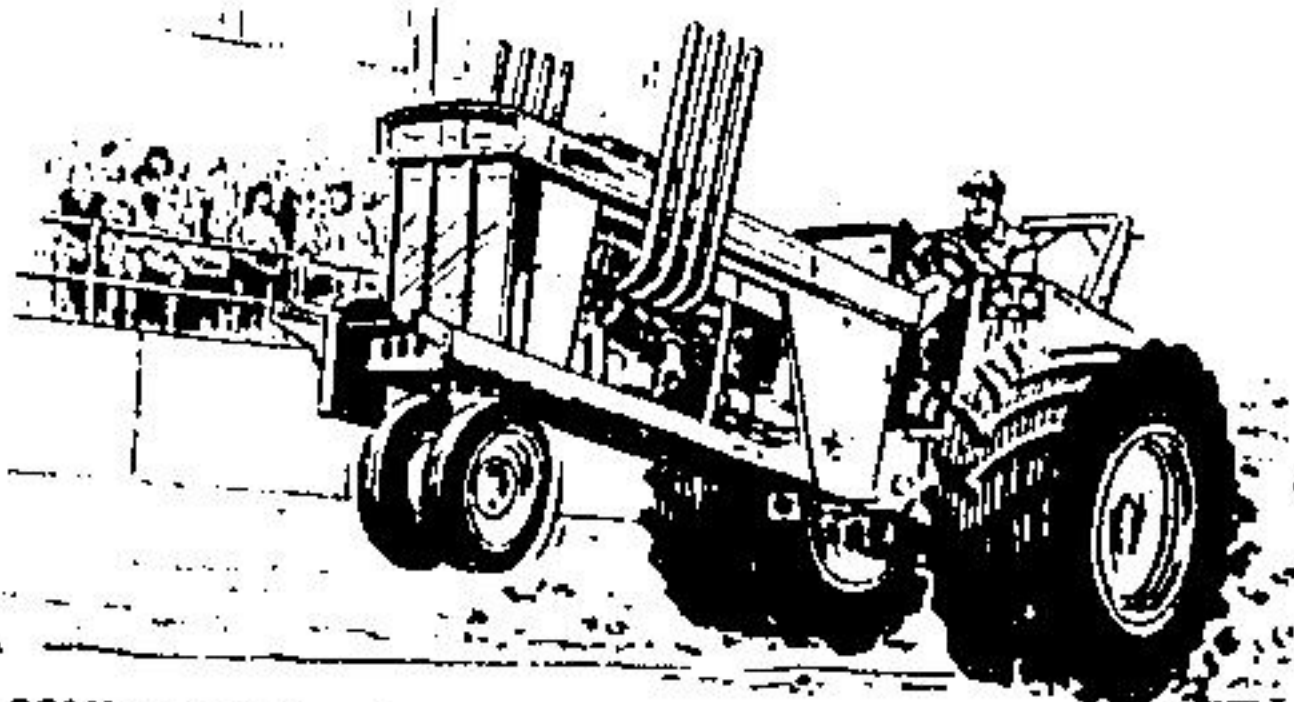
1. Ewe-"Two Tooth" (Two central permanent incisors) - Second pair of permanent incisors may be fully up. Other two pairs of temporary incisors ("milk teeth") must be firmly in place. Born the property of the exhibitor.
2. Ewe-"Full mouth milk teeth" (all eight temporary incisors). Born the property of the exhibitor.
3. Ram-"Two Tooth" (Two central permanent incisors) - Second pair of permanent incisors may be fully up. Other two pairs of temporary incisors ("milk teeth") must be firmly in place.
4. Ram-"Full mouth milk teeth" (all eight temporary incisors). Born the property of the exhibitor.
5. Get of Sire. (Born the property of the exhibitor). A group of three animals, full mouth milk teeth, by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented.
6. Breeder's Flock. (Bred and owned by exhibitor). A group of 4 animals, both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed.

SHEEP SPECIALS

7. A suitable trophy will be presented by Cliff Storey, and the Acton Agricultural Society for the Champion Flock, any breed. Winner's name will be engraved thereon, and the trophy will remain the property of the exhibitor for one year, then be returned to the Secretary for the Fair prior to September 1st, 1980 for competition.
 8. Best wether or ewe lamb shown by a boy or girl under 21 years of age. Age determined as of Fair day. Prize money for this section is as follows: \$5, \$5, \$4, \$4. Donated by C.J. Aitken.
 9. Showmanship class open to boy or girl under 21 years of age, exhibiting wether, or ewe lamb to be judged as follows: Showmanship 60 points, Lamb 40 points. Age determined as of fair day. A suitable trophy will be presented to the winner of this class, donated by B.J. Camer.

- STOCK TRACTOR RULES:** 1. Stock tractors must have no visual engine modifications, original pumps, no turbochargers unless manufacturer's option.
 2. Three point hitches may be removed.
 3. Drawbar length 18", drawbar must be stationary, maximum height of 20" from top of hitching device parallel to ground.
 4. No Four wheel drives and no duals.
 5. Weights must be securely fastened.
 6. Drivers must be 18 yrs. old.
 7. Only Stock Fuel to be used by tractors.

- GENERAL RULES:**
1. No one allowed on track except for officials and drivers.
 2. Tractors must be operated in safe manners.
 3. Driver must be seated during pull.
 4. No Passengers.
 5. All Tractors must stop immediately upon signal from Judge. The pull shall be considered over when forward motion of the load stops.
 6. No drinking at track.
 7. During hitching and unhitching tractors must be in neutral or park.
 8. Violation of any rule will result in disqualification.
 9. Each tractor will pull according to its own weight.
 10. Rules for contest will be available on day of the pull.
