

- 2. Three point hitches may be removed.
- 3. Drawbar length 18", drawbar must be stationary, maximum height of 20" from top of hitching device parallel to ground.
- 4. No Four wheel drives and no duals.
- Weights must be securely festened.
- 8. Drivers must be 18 yrs. old.
- 7. Only Stock Fuel to be used by tractors.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. No one allowed on track except for officials and drivers.
- 2. Tractors must be operated in safe mannes.
- 3. Driver must be scated during pull.
- 4. No Passangers.
- 5. All Tractors must stop immediately upon signal from Judge. The pull shall be considered over when forward motion of the load stops.

- 7. During hitching and unhitching tractors must be in neutral or park.
