required to report back to the Minister who still makes the final decision."

But the most frightening portion of the act, according to Mr. Johnson concerns Section 61 which regional staff found, puts the act over and above all other rules, statutes, and regulations.

"This act and its regulations take precedence over any other act, regulation or municipal bylaw," he said.

"This would include such necessary and valuable acts as the Environmental Protection Act, the Ontario Water Resources Act, Conservation Authorities Act, Niagara Escarpment Planning Development Act, and the Planning Act.

"At the very least, the Ministry should be required to take these acts and the related regulations into consideration in the approval of licences.

"The precedence of the Aggregate Act over all other legislation, implies a disrespect for other legitimate concerns.

"Authorities and agencies charged with enforcing the above legislation would have no control over pits and quarries operations, save and except those concerns the Minister wishes to include in his approval."

Mr. Johnson told this newspaper the act, as it now stands, allows anyone with a licence to go in and take sand and gravel from any land without having to worry about laws and regulations set by any other agency.

"It will come to the point that we will have to travel up to Algonquin Park if we want to see something natural," he said.

"What bothers me further is that there is no mention of pits and quarries in the north, only in southern Ontario, presumably because it is closer to the construction."

"I say that this is wrong. If this passes, it would be just disastrous," he said.

Mr. Johnson pointed out the Foundation for Aggregate Studies has already raised the red warning flag in a report on the discussion between the Ministry and the Ontario Mineral Aggregate Working Party.

A report to the foundation's board of directors states in part:

"These notes speak for themselves in that the Ministry of Natural Resources is proposing to implement the recommendations of the Working Party through unwritten policy."

"It has severe implications regarding our ability to impress upon municipalities that the working party's report is, in effect, law."

Mr. Johnson said, "unless we can do something to stop this through a concerted effort, we and our children are going to be paying for this for years to come."
